

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The local emergency began due to an intense winter storm that delivered extreme amounts of rainfall over the Riverside County Operational Area including the Canyon 1, Holy Fire, and Cranston Burn areas beginning February 13, 2019. The storm caused flooding, mud and debris flows which in turn caused the evacuation of residents, road closures, damage to property and critical infrastructure, and necessitated the rescue of residents to include numerous swift water resources. These conditions of extreme peril necessitated the proclamation of a local emergency by the Director of Emergency Services, which was ratified by the Board of Supervisors at their meeting of February 26, 2019.

It is requested that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution No. 2020-032 to terminate the Proclamation of Local Emergency. Approximately 16,700 County residents were evacuated from their homes or required to shelter in place and were at high risk of injury, death, or loss of property due to mud and debris flows from the Canyon 1, Cranston, and Holy Burn Scar areas. The situation resulting from said conditions of extreme peril is now deemed to be within the control of the normal protective services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of and within the County of Riverside.

16 now, therefore,


17 IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the
18 County of Riverside that said Local Emergency is hereby terminated.


