



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the reconstruction of an approximate 0.75 mile segment of Chicago Avenue from Palm Avenue to Cedar Avenue, and the resurfacing of Lloyd Street and Thomas Street both from Fairview Avenue to 0.10 mile east of Fairview Avenue in the Valle Vista community of Riverside County.

Three projects are combined to bid as one project in order to gain cost efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures and to seek more favorable bids associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed reconstruction of Chicago Avenue consists of removing the existing roadway, treating the base and underlying material with cement for greater strength and durability followed by overlaying with Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA) over Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). The proposed resurfacing of Lloyd Street and Thomas Street consist of removing the existing pavement, re-grading the surface and putting back new HMA concrete pavement.

Additional improvements include installation of asphalt concrete (AC) over-side drains, AC driveways and AC concrete dike, reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter, curb ramps, cross-gutters, and spandrels, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Chicago Avenue reconstruction, Lloyd Street and Thomas Street resurfacing projects are three of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

- Base Bid 1: Chicago Avenue reconstruction and associated road improvements
- Base Bid 2: Lloyd Street resurfacing and associated road improvements
- Base Bid 3: Thomas Street resurfacing and associated road improvements

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The proposed project will reconstruct Chicago Avenue from Palm Avenue to Cedar Avenue. Additionally, the project proposes to resurface Lloyd Street and Thomas Street. These improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Chicago Avenue, Lloyd Street and Thomas Street, totaling approximately one mile, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in late Spring of 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,719,724 and improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 4,030 feet of Chicago Avenue from Palm Avenue to Cedar Avenue. Chicago Avenue is classified as a local road in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Chicago Avenue is a two to four lane road and currently ranges from 25-64 feet wide with curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include removing the roadway, treating the base and underlying material with cement, and placing back Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and Asphalt Rubber Hot Mix (ARHM).

The proposed project will also include:

- Reconstruction of concrete curb/gutter, cross gutter, spandrel, and ADA deficient curb ramps
- Construction of asphalt concrete overside drain
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Striping of roadway to include bike lanes and a center median
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Driveway construction
- Vegetation removal/tree trimming
- Utility adjustments

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements. A traffic control plan may be needed during construction.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). Portions of the project are within cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside of cell criteria areas.

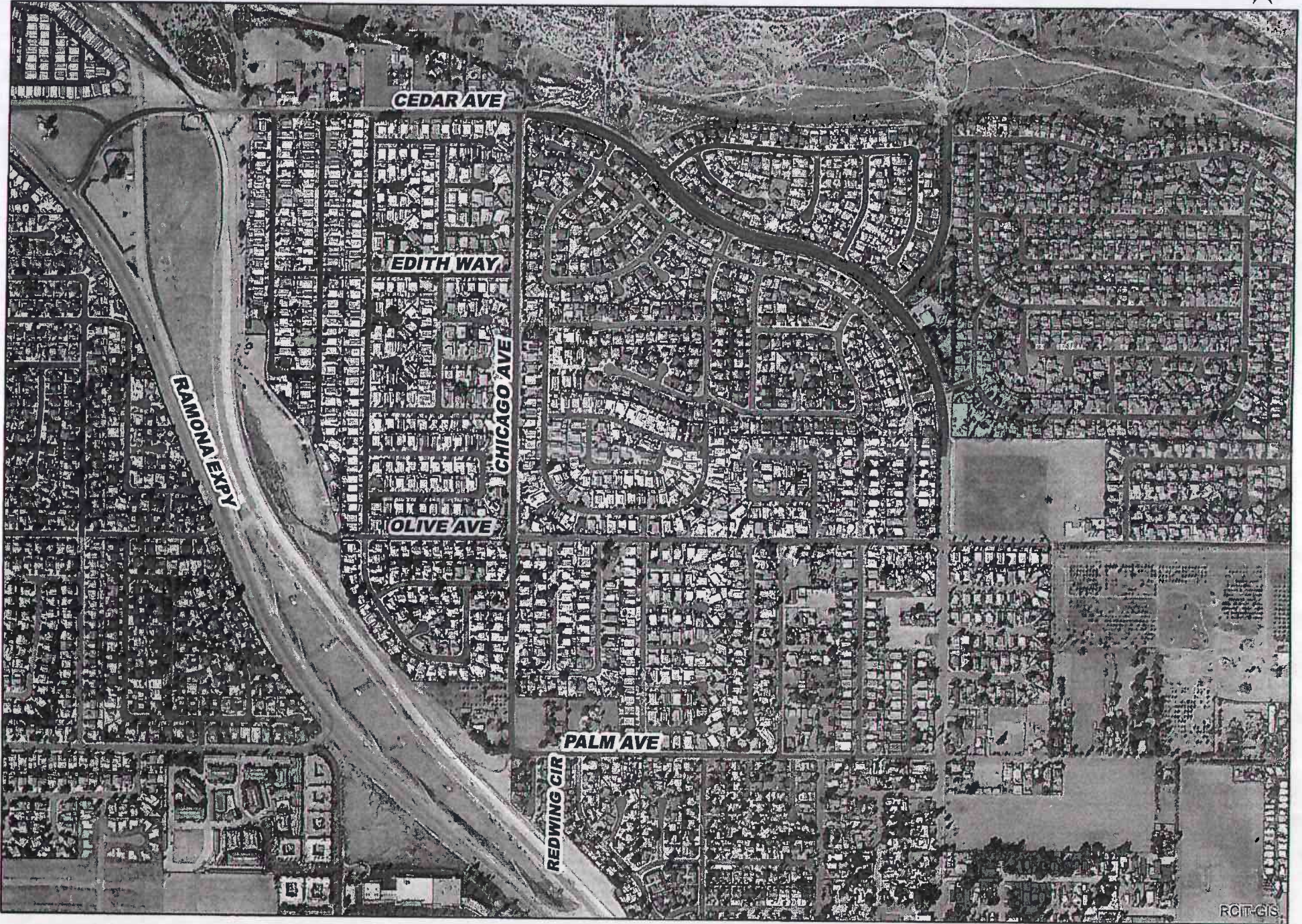

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) is proposing to resurface both Lloyd St and Thomas St from Fairview to 550 east of Fairview Ave. Lloyd St and Thomas St are classified as Local Streets. Lloyd St and Thomas St are both two lane roads that are 32 feet wide. The proposed project will include the following:

- Utility relocations

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements. A traffic control plan may be needed during construction.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project is outside cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside of cell criteria areas. This project will resurface existing roads and is considered to be an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st – September 1st), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface Lloyd St and Thomas St. This project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because it does not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

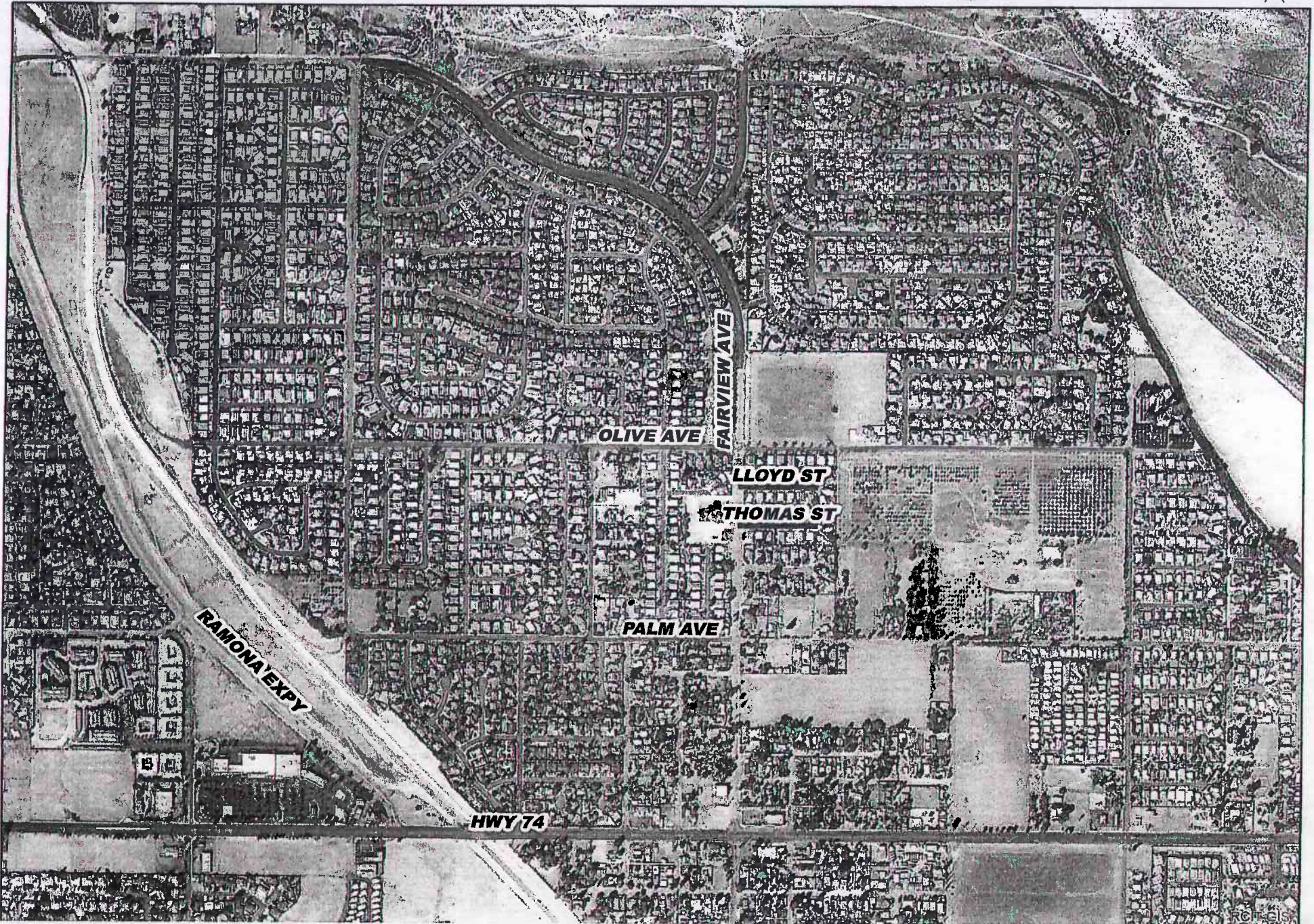
