

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the La Sierra Avenue Improvement Project from Cajalco Road to El Sobrante Road, approximately 2.4 miles, in the Community of Lake Mathews of the Riverside County.

The Transportation Department proposes to reconstruct a segment of La Sierra Avenue from Cajalco Road to 5,000-feet north. The remaining segment up to El Sobrante Road will receive a full width micro-surfacing slurry seal treatment.

Roadway rehabilitation is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed reconstruction of La Sierra Avenue consists of removing the existing roadway, treating the base and underlying material with cement for greater strength and durability followed by overlaying with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA).

The micro-surfacing slurry seal treatment consists of an application of a mixture of aggregates, water and other additives including polymer modified and fast setting asphalt emulsion allowing thicker layers to be placed. The thick layer application fills in ruts commonly found on roads with light to moderate truck traffic.

Additional improvements include replacing existing metal beam guard rail, striping of roadway including pavement markers and reflectors, and salvage/removal and installation of new road signs, and installation of a centerline rumble stripe to help alert drivers who may stray from the travel lanes.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the Transportation Department is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). La Sierra Avenue reconstruction project is one of Transportation Department's priority projects approved for use of

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the new Gas Tax/SB-1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid Schedule: La Sierra Avenue Reconstruction and Slurry Seal

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid received.

Environmental Findings

The improvements to La Sierra Avenue are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate a deteriorated segment of La Sierra Avenue between Cajalco Road and El Sobrante Road totaling approximately 2.4 miles, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in Summer of 2020. Construction will be performed at night in order to reduce impact to traffic and reduce delays. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately six weeks to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$1,956,700 and improvements will be funded with Gas Tax/SB-1 funds.

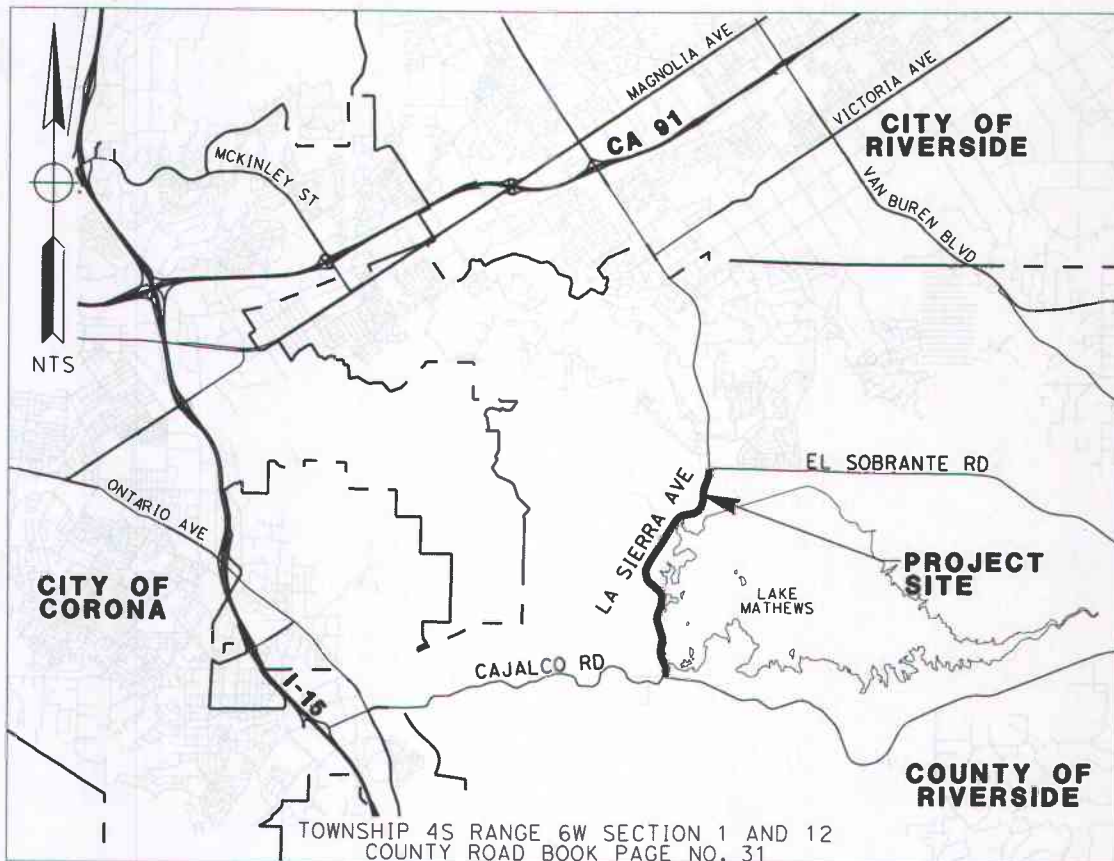
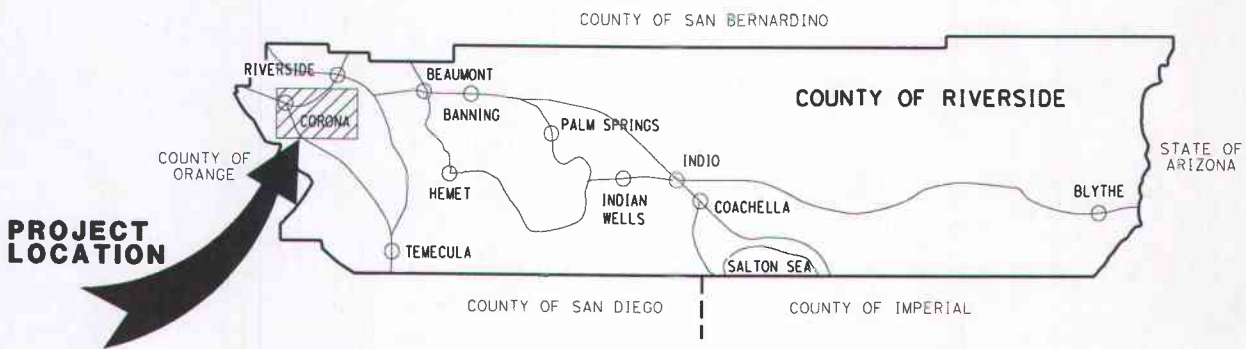

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to reconstruct and slurry seal approximately 2.3 miles of La Sierra Avenue from Cajalco Road to El Sobrante Road. La Sierra Avenue is classified as a Mountain Arterial in the County of Riverside's General Plan. La Sierra Avenue is a two lane road and currently ranges from 26-66 feet wide with dike along various segments of the roadway. La Sierra Avenue will be reconstructed from Cajalco Road to approximately 5,000 feet north of Cajalco Road and slurry sealed from 5,000 feet north of Cajalco Road to El Sobrante Road. Slurry seal treatments consist of an application of a mixture of asphalt emulsion, aggregate (very small crushed rock), water, and other additives over the existing asphalt pavement surface.

The proposed project will include:

- In the reconstruction portion: removing the roadway, cement stabilizing the soil, and placing back Hot Mix Asphalt
- In the slurry seal portion: applying micro-surfacing type II treatment to the roadway
- Removing excess material along the guardrail
- Re-grading of the shoulder
- Reconstruction of guardrail including addition of reflective markers
- Minor paved shoulder widening
- Application of center line and edge line rumble strip
- Utility/facility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project is within cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project will reconstruct, slurry seal, and conduct road maintenance within the roadbed of an existing road. The project is considered to be an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st – September 1st), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project will reconstruct and slurry seal La Sierra Avenue from Cajalco Road to El Sobrante Road. Additional road maintenance improvements will also be performed on La Sierra Avenue for this project. These improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

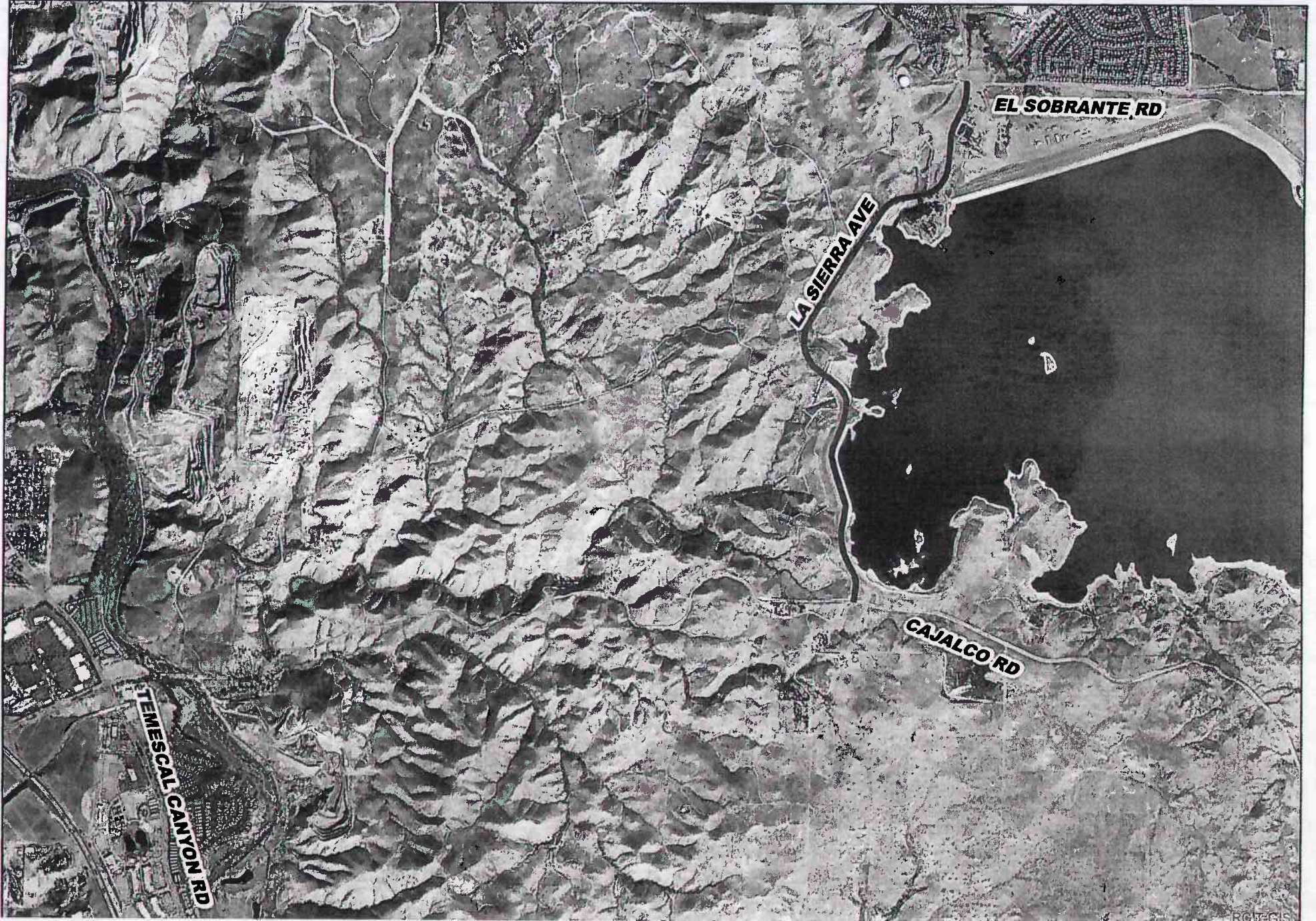
