

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Petco Foundation is a 501(c)(3) that partners with Petco stores and animal welfare organizations across the country for the purpose of increasing pet adoptions. Riverside County Department of Animal Services was selected to receive a \$55,000 Petco Foundation grant to support the Department's initiative to increase live release rates, and other lifesaving animal welfare work that is being done.

This Grant will be utilized to provide vaccinations, microchips, and spay or neuter services to animals being adopted. It will also be used to purchase equipment needed to provide pre/post-surgery holding space on-site in order to accommodate up to forty (40) cats.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The grant funding will have a positive impact on Riverside County residents and their pets. The grant funding will go towards lifesaving efforts. This will reduce the number of animals in the shelter and increase the Department's live release rate.
