

BACKGROUND:

Summary

On January 17, 2019, the Riverside County Sheriff's Department's Hazardous Device Team (HDT) received a UASI FY18 subaward from the City of Riverside Office of Emergency Management/UASI in the amount of \$350,000. The grant performance period is September 1, 2018 through May 31, 2021. UASI FY18 grant funds will be used to purchase a CBRNE (Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, Explosives) Tactical Response Vehicle, which will be used to transport bomb technicians and robotics responding to in-progress critical events (active shooter/bomber, armed barricades, acts of terrorism, etc.). The CBRNE Tactical Response Vehicle will provide crucial ballistic protection (not currently available) to both responding operators and robotics from fragmentation hazards (explosions) and gunfire, while allowing technicians to operate logistically closer to the hazard zone with optimum communication (conserving operational battery life and achieving uninterrupted command signals between operators and robotics). Sheriff's HDT (whose members are FBI-certified Bomb Technicians/ HAZMAT Specialists; CA POST-certified SWAT Operators) will use the CBRNE Tactical Response Vehicle to transport vital response personnel and equipment into life-threatening, crisis mitigation zones in shorter response times, greater effective outcomes, and increased hazards protection (to humans & robotics) – benefitting the Riverside County Operational Area, and supporting regional partner agencies in fulfillment of existing mutual aid agreements.

The Sheriff's Department intends to use Asset Forfeiture Sub Funds to purchase a mounted water nozzle for installation on the CBRNE Tactical Response Vehicle. The water nozzle will be used in firefighting emergencies.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The CBRNE Tactical Response Vehicle will allow the Sheriff's Hazardous Device Team and SWAT to respond to catastrophic, life-threatening incidents (including acts of violence/terrorism) more quickly, as technicians will be able to operate deeper into the hazard zone (closer to the hazard source) than current capabilities allow, addressing the threat/source more direct. This

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will be possible with the ballistics protection capability of the CBRNE Tactical Response Vehicle, which will protect both the officer-operators, the robotic interceptors, and the technology being relied upon for a unified response in the intervention and protection of life.
