SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 500.2 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 500 REDUCING THE PERMISSIBLE WEIGHT OF CERTAIN VEHICLES ON IDENTIFIED COUNTY HIGHWAYS

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 500.2 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

In summary, Ordinance No. 500.2 amends and replaces Ordinance No. 500 related to reducing the permissible weight of certain vehicles on identified County Highways in accordance with the California Vehicle Code, Sections 21101, 35701 through 35714 and 42030.1. The Board of Supervisors has the authority to reduce the permissible weight of commercial vehicles on select county highways that are within residential areas if the use is determined to adversely affect safety. This ordinance amendment restricts the maximum gross vehicle weight on certain county highways. The identified county highways subject to the restriction have been determined unsuitable for use by commercial vehicles in excess of 14,000 pounds (7 tons). The amendment includes alternate route designations for affected commercial vehicles. The restriction does not apply to all vehicles. Exemptions from the amendment include emergency response vehicles, school and public transit buses, commercial vehicles used for the purpose of delivering or loading for transportation goods, wares and merchandise, vehicles with a permit pursuant to Ordinance No. 499 or Ordinance No. 524, vehicles owned by a public utility or licensed contractor related to the maintenance of the public utility, or vehicles allowed to be parked on private property. Ordinance No. 500.2 would take effect 30 days after its adoption.
