BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside Sheriff's Department SWAT team and patrol units are responsible for the safety of all citizens and the community. In order to gain control and compliance during hostile situations, and without the use of lethal force, the department is seeking to purchase new launchers to use as a less-lethal alternative. The Department will be purchasing ninety (90) 40mm LMT Tactical Single Launcher with Expandable Stock, ten (10) 40mm LMT Tactical Single Launcher with Folding Stock, one-hundred (100) 40mm Complete Barrel with Cerakote Finish Orange, one-hundred (100) Munition Holders -Rogers Super-Stoc® Caddy, and one-thousand (1,000) 40mm eXact iMPact™ Sponge Rounds.

There will be no impact on the General Fund as the Department will use Asset Forfeiture Adjudicated Sub Funds to cover the expense.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no impact on residents and businesses.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Sheriff Purchasing released a Request for Quotation (RFQ) SHARC-430, soliciting proposals for the purchase of two types of 40MM LMT Less Lethal Launchers and accessories. The RFQ was advertised on Publicpurchase.com. A total of thirty-three (33) potential bidders viewed the RFQ. A total of three (3) bid responses were submitted. The proposals were all evaluated and based on the criteria set forth in the RFQ: ProForce Law Enforcement is the overall lowest responsive/responsible bidder. Based on this analysis, the department would like to purchase the launchers from ProForce Law Enforcement using Asset Forfeiture Adjudicated Sub Funds.
