BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Board approved a contract with Jacobsson Engineering Construction, Inc., in the amount of \$4,705,500 as Agenda Item Number 11.4 (MT#10918) on October 8, 2019.

Final inspection of the above-referenced project was made, and the project was found to be complete according to plans and specifications. A brief project description and location map is attached. The final price for the contract is \$4,560,123.05, which is 3% under the contract amount.

The District does not anticipate any claims for additional compensation from the Contractor.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This emergency work removed sediment and debris accumulation within Palm Canyon Wash that resulted from the February 14, 2019 severe winter storm. Removal of sediment and debris is necessary to restore the hydraulic capacity of the wash and provide adequate levee protection for the adjacent communities. Additionally, this work will continue to facilitate the ongoing processing of levee certification through the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) by restoring certification criteria which remedies ongoing flooding problems in the area, thus resulting in positive impacts to residents and businesses (see attached project description and location map).

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Pursuant to Public Contract Code 21091, invitation of sealed bids was solicited by advertising in print and digital media.

The final price for the contract is \$4,560,123.05, which is 3% under the contract amount.



The Palm Canyon Wash Flood Control Facility is located in the southern portion of the city of Palm Springs. The emergency work generally consists of sediment and debris removal from within the facility limits. Sediment removal operations will occur from approximately South Araby Drive downstream to South Gene Autry Trail.
