BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Tenaja Fire was a wildfire in the rural community of La Cresta southwest of Murrieta in Riverside County, located 80 miles from Los Angeles, California in the United States. The fire broke out on Wednesday, September 4, 2019 and ballooned to 1,926 acres over the course of two days. The Santa Rosa Plateau Ecological Reserve of approximately 9,000 acres was greatly impacted, including the loss of trees, benches, signs, and fencing due to fire. An amphitheater structure used for students as part of the Santa Rosa Plateau's Visitor Center's Interpretive and Education Program was also lost as the fire burned nearly 2,000 acres of the site. This project will replace and restore approximately 6,677 linear feet of three-strand braided barbed-less smooth wire fencing that was lost due to the Tenaja Fire.

IMPACT ON CITIZENS AND BUSINESSES

This project will restrict unauthorized access to the Santa Rosa Plateau Ecological Reserve, protecting woodlands, wetlands, native birds and nearly 50 endangered, threatened or rare animal and plant species.

ADDITIONAL FISCAL INFORMATION

The total project cost is estimated at \$85,000. The Santa Rosa Plateau Foundation, Inc. has assisted with fundraising portions of this project. Partners of the Santa Rosa Plateau Ecological Preserve are also assisting with funding for this project.

CEQA COMPLIANCE

The Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15302. The replaced or reconstructed fencing will be located in the same location as the former structure, and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity.

The DISTRICT is seeking bids for a project that is not to exceed \$85,000 dollars in construction cost. The DISTRICT has completed the bid set and the specifications for construction to restore fencing that was damaged or destroyed by the Tenja Fire back in 2019. This project shall be the construction and erection of approximately 6,677 linear feet of three-strand braided barbless smooth wire fencing. It is the responsibility of the contractor to determine the actual length of fencing to be erected Terminal Posts shall be 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" x 72" 15 gauge galvanized steel and must be cemented 24" below the ground's surface and 48" above the surface of the ground with at least a 6,500 psi concrete footing. 3,500 psi concrete footing for kickers. Terminal posts with kickers will be cemented in the ground at the ends and at the corners with 3,500 psi concrete footings for kickers. Terminal posts will be installed every 100 feet and at the top and bottom of inclines or as terrain dictates (as shown in Attachment D).

The performance period for this project including all project submittals, reviews and actual construction will last no more than thirty (30) calendar days or by August 31, 2020, whichever comes first. This is including project completion, punch list and issuance of the Notice of Completion. All work is to be completed no later than August 31, 2020 due to the sensitivity of the local wildlife.

Pay applications will be tied to the successful completion of all activities in both parts of the contract including the timely submission of all paperwork.

The awarded prime contractor shall post job site notices as prescribed by regulation at start of contract. Contractors and subcontractors shall furnish records specified in Labor Code Section 1776 to the Labor Commissioner, in the manner as required in Labor Code Section 1771.4.

In accordance with the provisions of California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the DISTRICT requires that the Bidders possess, at the time of submitting a bid for this project, at the time of award of a contract for the Project, and at all times during the Work, the following classifications of California Contractors License: "A" General Engineering License, or "B" General Contractor License with the appropriate Licensed "C" Specialty subcontractors in the State of California. Contractors whether General Contractor or specialty contractor proposed in this bid must hold a contracting license, active and in good standing, issued by the Contractors State License Board for the State of California for the appropriate license classifications required by applicable laws for the classifications of the work to be performed and be registered with the California Department of Industrial Relations. It is the responsibility of the Bidder to review the bid package and ensure that all licenses required to perform the Work contained herein have been obtained and are current, including checking to make certain a subcontractor listed possesses the appropriate license for the specialty subcontracted

This project requires the payment of prevailing wages and certified payroll.

Pursuant to Labor Code Section 1771.1, any contractors bidding and subcontractors to be listed on a bid proposal are subject to Public Contract Code Section 4104 and shall not be eligible to bid unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No contractor or subcontractor may enter into a contract without proof of current registration to perform public works.

The Bidder receiving the Award by the DISTRICT is required to comply with the provisions of the California Labor Code, including, without limitation, the requirements of California Labor Code Section 1720 et seq. requiring the payment of prevailing wages, submittal of payroll records, the training of apprentices and compliance with other applicable requirements. In accordance with provisions of Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations has ascertained the general prevailing rate of wages and employer payments for health and welfare, pension, vacation, and similar purposes applicable to the particular craft, classification, or type of workers employed on the work. The wage determinations shall be included in the bid specifications. The awarded prime contractor shall post all pertinent wage determinations on the jobsite at all times and shall post job site notices prescribed by regulations and comply with the provisions of the California Labor Code, including, without limitation, Sections 1771.4, 1773.1, 1774, 1775, 1776, and 1777.5.
