BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Department of Child Support Services (DCSS) provides services to the residents of Riverside County. The services include establishment of Paternity, establishment of child support and medical support orders, collection and distribution of child support orders, and enforcement of health care provisions.

Currently the department has locations in Riverside, Indio, Hemet, and Blythe. In 2019, DCSS became aware of the Riverside County Superior Court's intention of closing the Hemet Family Law Court and moving Court Services to a new Justice Center in Menifee.

For DCSS to continue to serve customers in the meet and confer process prior to court hearings, the department would like to explore location options that are available near the planned Menifee Superior Court. In addition to continuing to the meet and confer services, the Menifee office would also allow the department to expand services to the southwest region by including a customer service center for our participants and county residents to access services.

These services need to be provided in a private, confidential environment for clients to feel comfortable that sensitive and confidential information is being protected. Therefore, it is essential that the new office be near the new Menifee Superior Court. Adequate parking for staff and customers is another strong consideration.

Technology is essential to DCSS services as the department expands its use of teleconferencing. It is important that the location have adequate band width, Wi-Fi, and general technology associated with video conferencing. Having private interview rooms for the department staff to meet and discuss participants cases as well as upcoming court hearing is important, as is the need to have a medium size conference/training room to hold meetings and conduct training.

An exhaustive search was conducted by Facilities Management (FM) for existing county facility space that would meet the department's needs, however FM was unable to identify adequate proper space that met the departments requirements. The facility will need approximately 6,000 to 8,000 square feet of space to support the location. The noted square footage would

accommodate approximately 30 to 40 child support staff including Attorneys, paraprofessionals, and administrative staff.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

By opening a location in Menifee, DCSS will provide a positive impact to the residents of District 5 and the county as a whole by providing services in close proximity to where they live and the new court facility

No county general funds will be required. This facility will be wholly (100%) funded by State and Federal funds.
