BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Emergency Management Department (EMD) is seeking approval to make a cash purchase of a Ford F-250 truck using Emergency Management Program Grant (EMPG) 19 funds. EMD has cost savings from this grant and would like to purchase the vehicle with the remaining funds. Several options for a cash purchase of a vehicle have been identified in current dealership inventory. This vehicle will be used for the Senior EMS specialist in the Emergency Planning Division and will replace an older vehicle that will be retired.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purchase of the vehicle will have little to no impact to residents or businesses.
