#### BACKGROUND:

#### **Summary**

Implemented in 1999, the Records Management System (RMS) allows the Sheriff's Department and participating agencies the ability to enter case files, query case histories, and access to the Master Name Index, Warrants System, Master Location Index, Jail Locator Database, and the California Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (CLETS).

The Records Management System (RMS) cost is calculated annually by taking prior years' actual expenses and dividing it by the current year's estimated transaction count. The total costs for FY 2018-19 are \$1,953,544 and the estimated transaction count is 36,807,535. This results in a per transaction fee for FY 2019-20 of \$0.0531.

Allied agencies will be billed \$55,251, based on current estimated transactions, while Contract Cities will be billed \$1,526,543, based on 2018 actual transactions. Also, the Sheriff's Department utilizes this system and budgets for its portion of the allocated costs.

This request is to approve the FY2019-20 contract city cost allocation and the allied agency cost of \$0.0531 per transaction for access to the Sheriff's Records Management System (RMS). In FY 2018-19 the Board approved an RMS cost of \$0.0543 per transaction (06/18/19 3.26). The FY2019-20 RMS costs increased by \$180,492 due to an increase in software maintenance and subscription cost. However, due to a significant increase in the estimated number of RMS and CLETS transactions this fiscal year, there was an overall reduction in the rate.

#### Impact on Residents and Businesses

The Records Management System (RMS) provides all participating agencies access to the Master Name Index, Warrant System, Master Location Index, Jail Locator Database, and the California Law Enforcement Telecommunication System (CLETS). Access to RMS provides one shared database for law enforcement agencies to enter and query case histories to obtain criminal history information. Access and use of information increase public safety.
