For fiscal year 2020-21, there is no proposed inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 1 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 1 of the District is \$178.52 per acre.

Zone 1 was established 23 years ago with an assessment of \$178.52 per acre per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$14,777.88.

Zone 3

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is no proposed inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 3 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 3 of the District is \$77.68 per parcel.

Zone 3 was established 22 years ago with an assessment of \$77.68 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$24,391.52.

Zone 8

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 8 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 8 of the District is \$52.18 per EDU (Equivalent Dwelling Unit).

Zone 8 was established 20 years ago with an assessment of \$41.16 per edu per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$142,087.82.

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 10 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 10 of the District is \$428.66 per acre.

Zone 10 was established 19 years ago with an assessment of \$321.32 per acre per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$33,016.58.

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Zone 11

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 11 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 11 of the District is \$144.14 per parcel.

Zone 11 was established 16 years ago with an assessment of \$109.00 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$35,027.84.

Zone 15

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 15 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 15 of the District is \$442.44 per parcel.

Zone 15 was established 18 years ago with an assessment of \$345.50 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$53,536.38.

Zone 19

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 19 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 19 of the District is \$225.88 per parcel.

Zone 19 was established 18 years ago with an assessment of \$152.02 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$41,790.14.

Zone 24

Zone 24 was established 17 years ago with an assessment of \$100.00 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$44,674.30.

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Zone 26

The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 26 of the District is \$156.04 per parcel.

Zone 26 was established 17 years ago with an assessment of \$111.46 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$65,074.62.

Zone 28

The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 103 of the District is \$62.34 per parcel.

Zone 103 was established 12 years ago with an assessment of \$51.18 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$8,480.78.

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Zone 109

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 109 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 109 of the District is \$8.56 per parcel.

Zone 109 was established 12 years ago with an assessment of \$6.10 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$3,652.04.

Zone 110

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 110 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 110 of the District is \$121.16 per parcel.

Zone 110 was established 12 years ago with an assessment of \$99.58 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$10,299.34.

Zone 112

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 112 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 112 of the District is \$435.84 per parcel.

Zone 112 was established 12 years ago with an assessment of \$357.58 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$57,096.62.

Zone 119

For fiscal year 2020-21, there is a proposed two percent (2%) inflationary increase in the maximum assessment for Zone 119 and is consistent with ballot proposition approved by the qualified electors when establishing said zone. The proposed maximum assessment for fiscal year 2020-21 for Zone 119 of the District is \$1,171.86 per parcel.

Zone 119 was established 11 years ago with an assessment of \$980.60 per parcel per year. The proposed budget for 20-21 is \$5,859.34.

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Zone 123
