BACKGROUND:

Summary

Waste Collection Franchise Agreements covering most unincorporated portions of Riverside County were phased in between 1997 and 1998. Within each of the existing eleven Franchise Agreements is a provision for an annual adjustment of the rates effective each July 1st. The franchise areas (Areas) are spread throughout the entire county unincorporated area and are present within each Supervisor's District.

This adjustment allows a pass through for any changes to landfill costs including the Alternative Daily Cover surcharge or transfer station fees, plus an increase based on Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the balance of the rate. Costs are adjusted by the CPI for the Riverside/San Bernardino/Ontario, California, as published by the United States Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics. The proposed rates were adjusted as delineated in the franchise agreement using a CPI of 3.0% for the twelve (12) month period January 2019 through December 2019. DVD is subject to other increases that are dictated by their waste delivery agreements with Burrtec who operates the transfer stations at Edom Hill and Coachella and is reflected in the 3.61% increase in disposal costs noted on their rate sheets.

The detailed rate calculation worksheets factoring in the CPI increase have been reviewed for accuracy and the updated rate sheets are maintained by the Department of Environmental Health.

Recycling Processing Fees

California Law mandates each jurisdiction divert at least 50% of the waste material it generates. To meet that mandate, the waste haulers provide residential curbside recycling bins and commercial recycling bins to divert recyclables to processors and away for the landfill. In the past these programs provided the waste haulers with a marketable commodity that could be used to offset the costs associated with collection, processing and transporting recyclable materials to other markets. Recent changes in the global market for recyclable materials have had a negative impact on a large number of recyclable material types and raised the price of processing and moving material while also depressing the commodity prices of those materials. Foreign initiatives, such as Green Fence, National Sword and Blue Sky from China, have limited

or removed markets for materials while also causing a ripple effect of similar limitations or bans in other countries where recyclable materials were previously accepted.

For the 20/21 fiscal year, Desert Valley Disposal, Inc. (DVD) is requesting a \$0.10 increase over the base \$0.86 monthly recycling offset fee approved last year for all residential customers with recycling bins. Commercial recycling accounts will be increased an equivalent rate based on bin sizes and frequency of pick-up.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The current typical residential accounts pay \$25.21 a month. The approval of the proposed CPI increase and recycling processing fee increase would result in a rate of \$26.96 per month. Commercial customers rates vary based on the size of bins and frequency of services provided. Waste service would increase by 3.0% of the base rate. The recycling fees increase would only affect those commercial accounts that have subscribed to a recycling program.

The approval of this change will result in no cost to the County; implementation expenses are borne by the franchisee.

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE ESTABLISHING WASTE HAULER FEES

FOR DESERT VALLEY DISPOSAL, INC. IN FRANCHISE AREA 10

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 25827 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to prescribe terms and conditions for the collection of solid waste in the unincorporated areas of Riverside County; and

WHEREAS, California Public Resources Code section 40059 authorizes the County of Riverside to determine all aspects of solid waste handling which are of local concern, including whether the services are to be provided by nonexclusive franchise, and the charges and fees for such service; and

WHEREAS, Riverside County Ordinance 745 has established that a solid waste hauler, duly permitted or franchised by the County of Riverside, shall be entitled to payment for services rendered in the amounts as specified in a Resolution adopted by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes the benefits of entering into Waste Hauler Franchise Agreements for the efficiency of solid waste management; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside has entered into Waste Hauler Franchise Agreements with Desert Valley Disposal, Inc. (DVD) to cover Franchise Area 10; and

WHEREAS, the Waste Collection Franchise Agreement covering Franchise Area 10, contains a provision for an annual adjustment of the rates customers are charged based on the consumer price index ("CPI");

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors acknowledges the need for the CPI increase of the hauler fees to provide cost of living increase to address the costs of providing these services; and

WHEREAS, DVD has requested an increase to their Recycling Processing fee where applicable to cover the increased cost of recyclable processing State-wide;

BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, in regular session assembled on June 9, 2020, finds that the waste hauler fees in Franchise Area 10 shall receive an increase, based on the CPI of 3.0% to the service component of their fees for fiscal year 2020-2021 and approve the increase of the Recycling Processing fee to the existing rate sheets.
