BACKGROUND:

Summary

On June 20, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Resolution No. 2017-120, which authorized application for federal and state disaster assistance on behalf of the Riverside County Operational Area (OA) for a period of up to three years. The Form 11 and Authorized Agent Resolution as approved allowed Riverside County Emergency Management Department (EMD), as the authorized County representative, to request and receive funding from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services (CalOES) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and coordinate reimbursement funding in collaboration with the Auditor-Controller and affected departments as part of the financial long-term recovery process during a disaster.

A Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies is required of all Applicants to be eligible to receive funding. A new resolution must be submitted if a previously submitted Resolution is older than three (3) years from the last date of approval, is invalid or has not been submitted.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

CalOES and FEMA assist affected county departments in the identification of eligible projects/costs associated with a disaster. Once reviewed and approved, reimbursement funding is provided. The eligible reimbursement costs will be distributed to each department based on supporting documents provided to CalOES and FEMA during the recovery process.

Additional Fiscal Information

Emergency Management Department representatives applied and received recovery funding from CalOES and FEMA as a result of the approval of Resolution No. 2017-120 and enabled Riverside County departments and OA jurisdictions affected during various declared emergencies during the last three years to recover up to approximately 93% of disaster-related response and recovery costs, including eligible personnel and equipment.

15 Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster
16 Assistance Act; and, that the County of Riverside, a public entity established under the laws of the State
17 of California, hereby authorizes its agent(s) to provide to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services
18 for all matters pertaining to such state disaster assistance the assurances and agreements required. This is
19 a universal resolution and is effective for all open and future disasters up to three (3) years following the
20 date of approval.

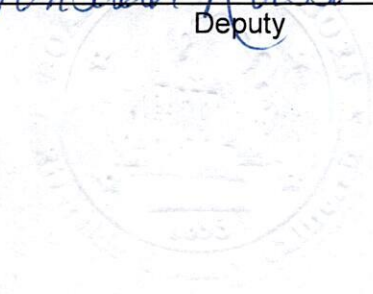
