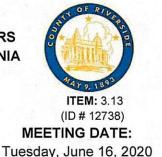

#### BACKGROUND:

#### **Summary**

On January 28, 2020 (Item 3.44), the Board of Supervisors approved the establishment of FY 20/21 rates for Supply Services and the approval of the Five-Year Capital Asset Plan. On May 6, 2020 the department was directed by the Executive Office to take reductions in response to the pandemic. The department reduced the Central Mail operational budget accordingly.

The department will be reducing staffing by one position, which is currently filled by a Temporary Assistance Pool (TAP) employee. On a regular basis the mail operations is impacted by absences due to injuries (Worker's Compensation Claims), sick vacation, childcare, etc. Nine staff will make it more difficult to meet the same day pick up and processing of outgoing mail, as mail routes will need to be modified. The department modifies routes to every other day when there is not enough staff. The department strives to meet customer departments' urgent demands when mail routes are modified due to absences, however, these urgent requests may increase as routes will be modified more frequently. This will result in the department not being able to guarantee response to these same day requests.

Central Mail is not requesting the use of unrestricted net assets in FY20/21; however, the department requests approval of the attached Five-Year capital asset plan.
