3. Authorize the Director of Facilities Management to administer the contract for the awarded low bidder in accordance with applicable Board Policies;
4. Delegate project management authority for Phase II of the Project to the Director of Facilities Management in accordance with applicable Board policies, including the authority to utilize consultants on the approved pre-qualified list for services in connection with the Project, and are within the approved project budget; and,


