BACKGROUND:

Summary

Conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons, property and critical infrastructure took place on June 5, 2020, due to a powerful storm system producing exceptionally high winds within Imperial Irrigation District's service territory located in the County of Riverside. The June 5, 2020 wind event damaged some of the district's energy infrastructure and other property located within the County of Riverside, including various transmission towers and lines and distribution poles and lines, resulting in an initial loss of electric utility service to approximately 4,500 district ratepayers located in Riverside County. The Imperial Irrigation District (IID), responsible for providing energy to the area of Thermal, has proclaimed a local emergency due to the severity of damage to their electrical infrastructure which is estimated at \$9 million. The County of Riverside in support of IID will work with State, Federal and local government resources to assist with response and recovery efforts.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The proclamation of local emergency will assist the Imperial Irrigation District to restore services and infrastructure to the affected areas of Riverside County.

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-164

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE RATIFYING AND EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency when the County Board of Supervisors is not in session. and

WHEREAS, on June 12, 2020, the Director of Emergency Services for the County of Riverside ("County") proclaimed a Local Emergency based upon the following findings:

- (1) That at the time of the proclamation the County Board of Supervisors was not is session:
- (2) That on Friday, June 5, 2020, a powerful windstorm event producing exceptionally high winds caused conditions of disaster or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within Imperial Irrigation District's service territory located in the County of Riverside:
- (3)That on June 6, 2020, the district's Office of Emergency Management Supervisor declared the existence of a "local emergency" in connection with the June 5, 2020 storm event, which was ratified by the Imperial Irrigation District's governing board on June 10, 2020;
- That said service territory within the County of Riverside experienced loss of power due to (4) 53 downed transmission poles, and various distribution poles, lines and associated infrastructure located in the vicinity of Mecca, California causing approximately \$9,000,000.00 in damage and emergency protective measures implemented by IID; and
- That the County of Riverside, in support of the Imperial Irrigation District, proclaims a local (5)emergency; and

WHEREAS the local state of emergency shall not remain in effect after seven (7) days from the date of proclamation unless it has been ratified by the Riverside County Board of Supervisors; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that the Proclamation of a Local Emergency issued by the Director of Emergency Services on June 12, 2020 is hereby ratified, and that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist until its termination is proclaimed by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.

PROCLAMATION OF A LOCAL EMERGENCY

FOR THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, Riverside County Ordinance No. 533 empowers the Director of Emergency Services to proclaim the existence of a Local Emergency when the County Board of Supervisors is not in session, and

WHEREAS, the Director of Emergency Services finds:

- (1) That at the time of this proclamation the County Board of Supervisors is not is session;
- (2) That conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the County of Riverside caused by a powerful windstorm event on June 5, 2020 producing exceptionally high winds which cased extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the affected areas of the County of Riverside; and
- (3) That the Imperial Irrigation District (IID) has proclaimed a local emergency within Imperial Irrigation District's Riverside County service territory; and
- (4) That said service territory within the County of Riverside experienced loss of power due to 53 downed transmission poles, and various distribution poles, lines and associated infrastructure located in the vicinity of Mecca, California causing approximately \$9,000,000.00 in damage and emergency protective measures implemented by IID,; and
- (5) That the County of Riverside, in support of the Imperial Irrigation District, proclaims a local emergency; and
- (6) That the aforesaid conditions of extreme peril warrant and necessitate the proclamation of a Local Emergency; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED that a Local Emergency exists throughout the County of Riverside, commencing on or about 5 p.m. of the 571 day of 2020, and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that during the existence of said Local Emergency, the powers, functions and duties of the Director of Emergency Services shall be those

prescribed by state law and the ordinances, resolutions, and approved plan of the County of Riverside in order to mitigate the effects of said Local Emergency, and

IT IS FURTHER PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED that said Local Emergency shall be deemed to continue to exist for the next seven (7) days, and hereafter by ratification of the County Board of Supervisors, until its termination is proclaimed by the County Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside.
