

1. Accept the results of the official canvass of the votes cast at the 28th Senate District Special General Mail Ballot Election held on May 12, 2020.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

In accordance with California Elections Code §§ 15301, 15372 and 15374, the official canvass of votes for the May 12, 2020 28th Senate District Special General Mail Ballot Election has been completed and is forwarded for acceptance by the Board. Attached is the Certificate of the Registrar of Voters and the Statement of Votes cast.

On April 7, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved the conduct of election services for the 28th Senate District Special General Mail Ballot Election. The estimated cost for the May 12, 2020 election is \$1,500,000. The State will not reimburse the county for the cost of the special election.

The election was successfully held on May 12, 2020 with 39.03% turnout. Staff recommends that the Board accepts the results of the official canvass of votes cast for the 28th Senate District Special General Mail Ballot Election.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Registered voters who reside in the 28th State Senate District had the opportunity to select a new state senator.

Additional Fiscal Information

As approved by the Board of Supervisors on April 7, 2020, the county will not receive reimbursement from the State for the cost of the special election.
