BACKGROUND: Community Improvement Designation Funds will be allocated to two (2) 2020 High School Graduates, who served on the Fifth District Youth Advisory Council, and are recipients of a Fifth District Scholarship.

1. This scholarship award is designed to award Fifth District Youth Advisory Council (YAC) Members hard work, assist in their education and improve our community.
 - a. All 12th grade YAC members were able to apply for this scholarship.

2. Eligibility considerations are as follows:
 - a. Graduating seniors attending community colleges, public colleges universities, private universities, or eligible trade schools (proof of acceptance required)
 - b. Total number of hours that were contributed to the council
 - c. Total number years student served as a member on the YAC (up to \$250 per year served)
 - d. Essay submitted for review that demonstrates growth, community contributions and learning
