RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction, Mesa Drive Resurfacing and Hobson Way Resurfacing Projects are categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) - Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction, Mesa Drive Resurfacing, and Hobson Way Resurfacing Projects, in the Communities of River Valley, Mesa Verde and East Blythe;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Department proposes to resurface two roads segments and reconstruct one road segment in the communities of River Valley, Mesa Verde and East Blythe of eastern Riverside County. The following roads are included:

Road Name	Begin	End	Road Segment Length
Lovekin Blvd.	Seeley Avenue	to 4,400 feet north of Seeley Avenue	0.85 miles
Mesa Drive	Bellwood Drive	to Black Rock Road/ Hobson Way	0.25 miles
Hobson Way	Florence Blvd. (West)	to 2,680 feet east of De Frain Blvd	1.2 miles

The three road projects are being combined to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to seek more favorable bid costs associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing and reconstruction is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed reconstruction of Lovekin Boulevard and resurfacing of Hobson Way consists of grinding the existing asphalt concrete pavement in place and placing new hot mix asphalt. The proposed resurfacing of Mesa Drive consists of removing the existing pavement, re-grading the surface and placement of new asphalt concrete pavement. Shoulder backing material will be placed to protect the outside edge of pavement to prevent edge cracking and pavement edge deterioration.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of driveways, curb ramp, asphalt concrete dike, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to

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improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Lovekin Boulevard reconstruction, Mesa Drive resurfacing, and Hobson Way resurfacing projects are three of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

- Base Bid 1: Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction and associated road improvements
- Base Bid 2: Mesa Drive Resurfacing and associated road improvements
- Base Bid 3: Hobson Way Resurfacing and associated road improvements
- Alternative Bid 1: Hobson Way Resurfacing – City of Blythe Portion

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid. If the low bid is approved and concurred to by the City of Blythe for their respective alternative bid schedule of work, then a reimbursement agreement between the City and County will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval prior to or concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

Environmental Findings

The projects propose to resurface or reconstruct segments of Lovekin Boulevard, Mesa Drive, and Hobson Way. These proposed projects are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing and reconstruction of the roadways does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Lovekin Boulevard, Mesa Drive, and Hobson Way, totaling approximately two miles, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in late Fall of 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to rehabilitate the following road segments:

- Resurface approximately 4,400 feet of Lovekin Boulevard from Seeley Avenue to approximately 4,400 feet north of Seeley Avenue. Lovekin Boulevard is a two lane road, classified as an Arterial Highway in the County of Riverside general plan, and currently ranges from 40-52 feet wide with curb along a segment of the roadway.
- Resurface approximately 6,283 feet of Hobson Way from west of Florence Boulevard to 2,680 feet east of De Frain Boulevard. Hobson Way is a two lane road, classified as an Arterial Highway in the County of Riverside general plan, and currently ranges from 32-71 feet wide with curb/gutter and dike along various segments of the roadway.
- Reconstruct approximately 0.25 miles of Mesa Drive from Bellwood Drive to Black Rock Road/Hobson Way. Mesa Drive is a two lane road, classified as a Secondary Highway in the County of Riverside General Plan, and currently ranges from 30-84 feet wide with dike along various segments of the roadway

The proposed projects will include the following:

- Removal or pulverization of the roadway
- Placing back or overlaying roadway with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Reconstruction of concrete curb, cross gutter, spandrel, and ADA deficient curb ramp
- Reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike and overside drain
- Construction of asphalt concrete driveway
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

Improvements will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required.

If tree or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season from March 1 to September 1, a pre-construction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

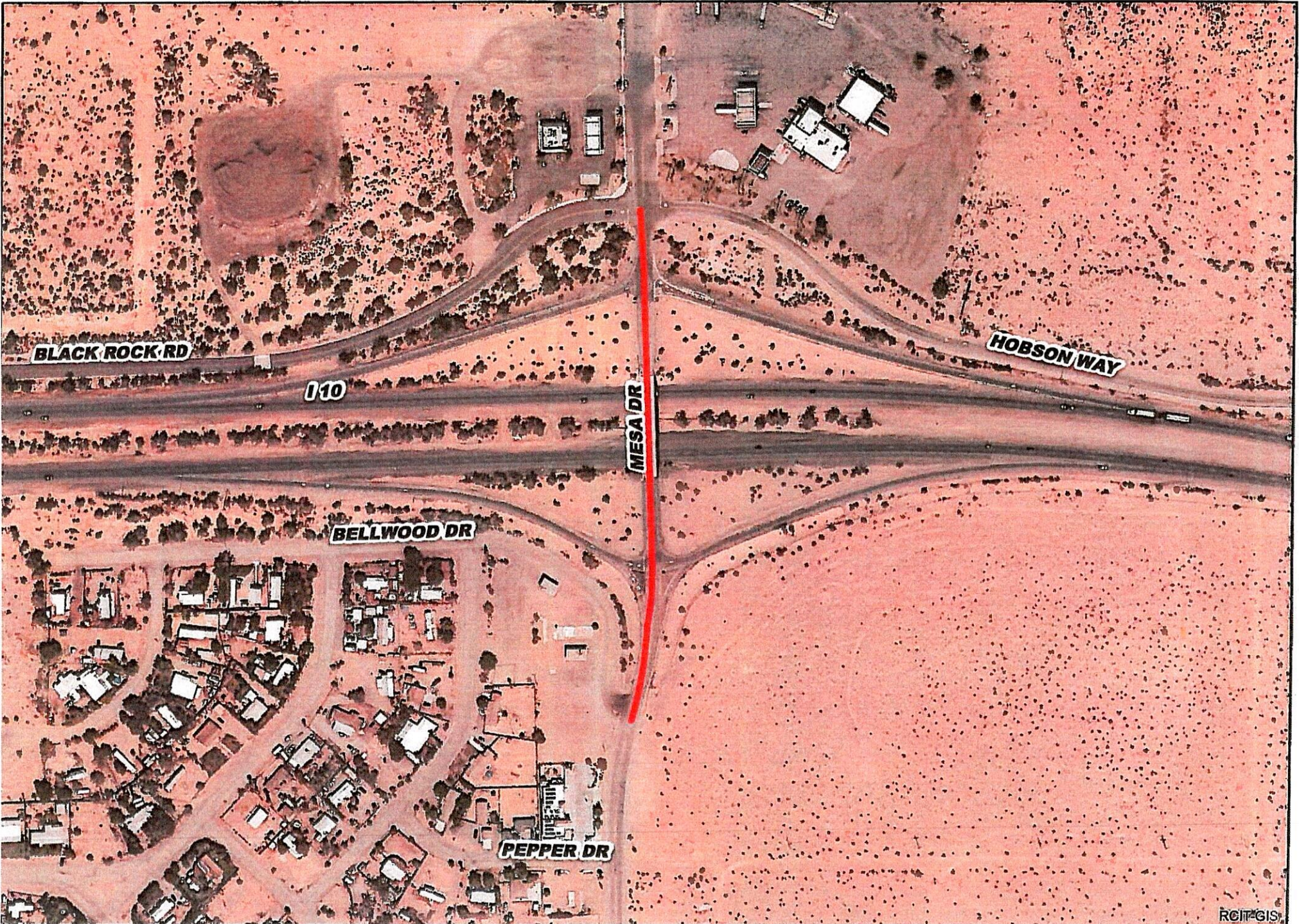
