2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption for the El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project, in the El Cerrito Area with the County Clerk for posting within five working days;
3. Approve the addendum to the plans and specifications issued prior to the April 29, 2020, bid opening;
4. Accept the low bid of All American Asphalt, Inc. of Corona, California in the amount of \$2,499,955;
5. Award the contract to All American Asphalt, Inc. and authorize the Chairman of the Board to execute the contract documents; and
6. Approve the project proposed budget as shown in Attachment "A".

BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated April 7, 2020 (Agenda Item 3.65), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the La Sierra Avenue Reconstruction and Slurry Seal Project, in the Community of Lake Mathews in Riverside County.

The project proposes to reconstruct a segment of La Sierra Avenue from Cajalco Road to 5,000-feet north. The remaining segment up to El Sobrante Road will receive a full width micro-surfacing slurry seal treatment.

Additional improvements include replacing existing metal beam guard rail, striping of roadway including pavement markers and reflectors, and salvage/removal and installation of new road signs, and installation of a centerline rumble stripe to help alert drivers who may stray from the travel lanes.

During the advertisement, period one addendum was issued to all registered plan holders as a supplement to the plans and specifications. Bidders were required to acknowledge and take into account the issued addendum in their contractor's Bid in order to be considered for award. The addendum is attached and designated as Addendum No. 1.

The addendum was issued to include an additional project titled the El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project, which includes the following seven roads: Grandview Drive, Grant Street, Katy Way, Marilyn Drive, Washington Street, Frances Street and Evelyn Street.

Roadway rehabilitation is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions.

El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project was combined with the La Sierra Avenue reconstruction project to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to seek more favorable bid costs associated with larger bid quantities.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The La Sierra Avenue reconstruction project and the El Cerrito Area rehabilitation project are Transportation Department's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The contract includes the following schedules of work:

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bond documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Environmental findings: La Sierra Avenue Reconstruction and Slurry Seal Project

The Board of Supervisors found that the improvements to La Sierra Avenue were categorically exempt from CEQA and directed the Clerk of the Board to file the Notice of Exemption by Minute Order dated April 7, 2020 (Agenda Item 3.65).

Environmental findings: El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project

The project proposes to rehabilitate several existing paved roads in the County area of El Cerrito. The proposed improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the resurfacing of the road and additional safety improvements do not create additional automobiles lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of the projects is to rehabilitate the deteriorated segment of La Sierra Avenue between Cajalco Road and El Sobrante Road totaling approximately 2.4 miles, and El Cerrito Area roads noted above to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

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STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

The work is scheduled to begin in the Summer of 2020 and it will take approximately one month to complete. Construction will be performed at night in order to reduce impact to traffic and reduce delays. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The Transportation Department recommends award of the Contract to All American Asphalt, Inc. in the amount of \$2,499,955. The Construction contract will be funded with Gas Tax/SB1 funds.

The proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A" includes the Contract award amount and other associated costs. There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Three (3) bids were received ranging from \$2,499,955 to \$2,847,957. The basis for the selection of a bid is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by All American Asphalt, Inc. in the amount of \$2,499,955 which is \$354,067 (12.4%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to rehabilitate several existing paved roads in the community of El Cerrito listed below. The roads listed below are classified as local roads in the County of Riverside's General Plan. The roads are two lane roads ranging from 16-26 feet wide with dike along various segments of the roadways. The proposed project will include the reconstruction of the road within the project limits as identified below. The project will also include minor widening to provide a minimum 20 foot roadway in narrow areas. Additional work includes reconstruction of dike, striping of roadway, upgrading signs, utility adjustments and reconstruction of curb ramps to meet ADA standards.

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements will not be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project is not within cell criteria areas. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within and outside cell criteria areas. This

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project will rehabilitate several existing roads within the roadbed of the existing roads. The project is considered to be an operation and maintenance project and therefore is a covered activity.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1st – September 1st), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The County of Riverside Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The proposed project will rehabilitate several existing paved roads in the community of El Cerrito. These improvements are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

THIS CONTRACT is entered into at Riverside, California as of the date set forth below is between County of Riverside hereafter called "County" and All American Asphalt, hereafter called "Contractor".

WITNESSETH

Recitals:

1. Contractor has submitted to County his Contractor's Proposal for the construction of County Project, La Sierra Avenue Reconstruction and Slurry Seal Project, Cajalco Road to El Sobrante Road, Lake Mathews Area, Project No. C8-0053; and El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project, Grandview Drive, Grant Street, Katy Way, Marilyn Drive, Washington Street, Frances Street, and Evelyn Street, El Cerrito Area, Project No. D0-0026, D0-0027, D0-0028, D0-0029, D0-0030, D0-0077, and D0-0078, in strict accordance with the Contract Documents identified below and County has accepted said Proposal.
2. Contractor states that he has reexamined his Contractor's Proposal and found it to be correct, has ascertained that his subcontractors are properly licensed and possess the requisite skill and forces, has reexamined the site and Contract Documents and is of the opinion that he can presently do the work in accordance with the Contract Documents for the money set forth in his Proposal to be paid as provided in the Contract Documents.

Agreement:

It is agreed by the parties as follows:

1. Contract Documents

The entire Contract consists of the following: (a) The Construction Contract, (b) The Notice to Bidders, (c) The Instruction to Bidders, (d) The Bid, (e) The Bid Bond, (f) The Payment Bond, (g) The Performance Bond, (h) The General Conditions, (i) The Special Provisions, (j) The Standard Specifications of the State of California Department of Transportation edition of 2018 as modified in other portions of the Contract Documents and as amended by the State of California Department of Transportation, (k) The Standard Plans of the Department of Transportation identified on the plans or in the Special Provisions, (l) The Plans, (m) Addenda (One) , (n) The Determination of Prevailing Wage Rates for Public Works, (o) Any Change Orders issued, and (p) Any additional or supplemental specifications, notice, instructions and drawings issued in accordance with the provisions of the Contract Documents. All of said Documents presently in existence are by this reference incorporated herein with like effect as if here set forth in full and upon the proper issuance of other documents they shall likewise be deemed incorporated. The Bid Bond is exonerated upon execution of this Contract and the Payment Bond and Performance Bond.

2. The Work

Contractor shall do all tasks necessary to construct the work generally described in Recital No. 1 in accordance with the Contract Documents.

3. Prosecution, Progress and Liquidated Damages

Attention is directed to the provisions in Section 8-1.04, "Start of Job Site Activities", Section 8-1.05, "Time", and in Section 8-1.10 "Liquidated Damages" of the Standard Specifications and these Special Provisions.

Standard Specification Section 8-1.04B, "Standard Start" is modified to read as follows:

The Contractor shall begin work within fifteen (15) calendar days, or as revised in the Special Provisions, of the date stated within the written "Notice to Proceed".

The Contractor shall notify the Engineer, in writing, of the Contractor's intent to begin work at least 72 hours before work is begun. If the project has more than one (1) location of work, Contractor shall submit a separate notice for each location. The notice shall be delivered to the Transportation Department's Construction Engineer and shall specify the date the Contractor intends to start at said location.

Should the Contractor begin work in advance of receiving a written "Notice to Proceed", any work performed by the Contractor in advance of the date stated in the "Notice to Proceed" shall be considered as having been done by the Contractor at his own risk and as a volunteer and subject to the following:

- A. The Contractor shall, on commencing operations, take all precautions required for public safety and shall observe all the provisions in the Specifications and the Special Provisions.
- B. All work done according to the Contract, prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed", will be considered authorized work and will be paid for as provided in the contract.
- C. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any additional compensation or an extension of time for any delay, hindrance or interference caused by or attributable to commencement of work prior to the issuance of the "Notice to Proceed".

4. Compensation

Contractor shall be paid in the manner set forth in the Contract Documents the amount of his Proposal as accepted by County, the above rates, subject to additions and deductions as provided in the Contract Documents. Said Proposal is on file in the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of County.

13-1.01(A) General

WATER POLLUTION CONTROL (SANTA ANA REGION):

Throughout the term of this contract, the total land disturbance area of shall be less than 1 acre. Contractor shall prepare a Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP) for El Cerrito Area Rehabilitation Project.

The Contractor shall comply the Area-Wide Municipal Stormwater Permit NPDES No. CAS 618033, hereafter referred to in this section as the “Municipal Permit”, issued by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board (CRWQCB) – Santa Ana Region. This Permit regulates both stormwater and non-

stormwater discharges associated with Contractor's construction activities. A copy of the Permit may be obtained at the office of the County of Riverside Transportation Department, 14th Street Transportation Annex, 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California. (951) 955-6780, or may be obtained on the internet at: <http://www.waterboards.ca.gov/santaana/>

The Contractor shall comply with the requirements of the Municipal Permit, and all other applicable federal, state and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules, and regulations concerning water pollution control.

The WPCP shall include Fact Sheets for all selected project BMPs.

Contractor's Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP) shall be prepared by a Qualified SWPPP Developer in accordance with Section 3, "Preparing a Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP)", of the *Caltrans Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and Water Pollution Control Program (WPCP) Preparation Manual*, which is available as a free download from:

13-1.01(B) WATER POLLUTION CONTROL MEASURES

- A. Work having the potential to cause water pollution shall not commence until the Contractor's WPCP has been reviewed and approved by the Engineer. The Engineer's review and approval of the Contractor's WPCP shall not waive any contractual requirements and shall not relieve the Contractor from achieving and maintaining compliance with all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules, and regulations. A copy of Contractor's WPCP shall be maintained onsite. When the WPCP or access to the construction site is requested by a representative of a federal, state, or local regulatory agency, Contractor shall make the WPCP available and Contractor shall immediately contact the Engineer. Requests from the public for the Contractor's WPCP shall be directed to the Engineer.
- B. Contractor's WPCP shall describe the Contractor's plan for managing run-on and runoff during each construction phase. Contractor's WPCP shall describe the Best Management Practices (BMPs) that will be implemented to control erosion, sediment, tracking, construction materials, construction wastes, and non-stormwater flows. BMP details shall be based on the Caltrans Construction Site BMP Manual (<http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/construc/stormwater/manuals.htm>). Contractor's WPCP shall describe installation, operation, inspection, maintenance, and monitoring activities that will be implemented for compliance with the Municipal Permit and all applicable federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules, and regulations related to the protection of water quality.
- C. The Contractor's WPCP preparer shall have been trained to prepare WPCPs or SWPPPs and shall have previous experience with preparing SWPPP or WPCP requirements on a previous project.

The Contractor shall designate a Water Pollution Control Manager that shall have been trained to implement WPCP or SWPPP requirements. Contractor's Water Pollution Control Manager shall:

1. Be responsible for all water pollution control work.
2. Be the Engineer's primary contact for all water pollution control work.
3. Have the authority to mobilize resources (crews, supplies, equipment, etc.) to make immediate repairs of water pollution control measures or to supplement water pollution control measures to maintain compliance with all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations related to the protection of water quality, including the Municipal Permit.

The WPCP shall contain all required and applicable certifications and evidence of training for the Water Pollution Control Manager, WPCP Developer, and all other employees working on the project receiving formal training or certification.

- D. **Water Pollution Control Training:** Contractor shall provide water pollution control training to Contractor's employees and subcontractors prior to their performing work on the work site. The water pollution control training shall be appropriate to the employee or subcontractor function and area of responsibility and shall address (as applicable):
1. Erosion Control (water and wind)
 2. Sediment Control
 3. Tracking Control
 4. Materials & Waste Management
 5. Non-Stormwater Discharge Management
 6. Run-on and Run-off Control
- E. **Monitoring and Reporting:** Observations and inspections conducted by the Contractor's Water Pollution Control Manager shall be documented on the Construction Site Inspection Checklist included in Contractor's WPCP. A copy of each completed Construction Site Inspection Checklist shall be submitted to the Engineer within 24 hours of conducting the inspection.

13-1.01(C) General Requirements

In the event the County incurs any Administrative Civil Liability (fine) imposed by the CRWQCB – Santa Ana Region, the State Water Resources Control Board, or EPA, as a result of Contractor's failure to fully implement the provisions of "Stormwater and Non-Stormwater Pollution Control", the Engineer, may, in the exercise of his sole judgment and discretion, withhold from payments otherwise due Contractor a sufficient amount to cover the Administrative Civil Liability including County staff time, legal counsel, consultant support costs and all other associated cost.

The Contractor shall be responsible for all costs and for any liability imposed by law as a result of the Contractor's failure to comply with the requirements set forth in "Water Pollution Control", including but not limited to, compliance with the applicable provisions of the Caltrans Handbooks, Municipal Permit, Federal, State, and local regulations. For the purpose of this paragraph, costs and liabilities include, but not limited to, fines, penalties, damages, and costs associated with defending against enforcement actions whether taken against the County or the Contractor, including those levied under the Federal Clean Water Act and the State Porter-Cologne Water Quality Act.

13-1.01(D) Submittals

Within fifteen (15) working days after the award of the contract, the Contractor shall submit one pdf. file of the WPCP to the Engineer for review and approval. The Contractor shall allow ten (10) working days for the Engineer to review the WPCP. If revisions are required as determined by the Engineer, the Contractor shall revise and resubmit the WPCP within three (3) working days of receipt of the Engineer's comments and shall allow ten (10) working days for the Engineer to review the revisions. The Contractor shall submit two (2) copies of the approved WPCP and one pdf. file to the Engineer prior to notice to proceed. The Contractor must have an approved WPCP prior to the notice to proceed.

13-1.01(E) WPCP Implementation

Unless otherwise directed by the Engineer or specified in these Special Provisions, the Contractor's responsibility for WPCP implementation shall continue throughout any temporary suspension of work ordered in accordance with Section 8-1.05, "Temporary Suspension of the Work", of the Standard Specifications. The Engineer may withhold progress payments or order the suspension of construction operations without an extension of the contract time, if the Contractor fails to comply with the requirements of "Water Pollution Control" as determined by the Engineer.

All BMP repairs shall be implemented by the Contractor within 72 hrs of notification by Engineer.

**13-1.01(F) Additional Liquidated Damages:
Water Pollution Control and WPCP**

If the Contractor fails to comply with the requirements of Special Provisions Section 13, "Water Pollution Control", all referenced requirements in this section, and the approved Water Pollution Control Program, the Contractor shall pay to the County of Riverside the sum of **\$500.00** per day for each and every working day after the expiration of 72 hours written notification from the Engineer.

13-1.01(G) Payment

Payment for Water Pollution Control shall be on a lump sum basis as listed in bid proposal as Prepare Water Pollution Control Program and shall include full compensation for the work performed, including, developing, preparing, revising, obtaining approval of, and amending the WPCP, implementing, installing, constructing, operating, maintaining, and removing and disposing of temporary BMPs, performing the observations, inspections, sampling, analysis, reporting, and street sweeping, and as specified in the Caltrans Handbooks, Municipal Permit and these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Item 16: Miscellaneous Areas and Dikes. The following special provisions are added a made part hereby:

Add to Section 39-2.01C(9), Miscellaneous Areas and Dikes:

39-2.01C(9)A Miscellaneous Areas and Dikes

Asphalt concrete dike and miscellaneous areas shall conform to the applicable provisions in Section 39-2, "Hot Mix Asphalt", of the Standard Specifications, in accordance to the applicable Standards Plans and details shown in the plans, these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

This work includes producing and placing hot mix asphalt (HMA) **Type A.**

Asphalt binder to be mixed with the aggregate for AC Dike and miscellaneous areas shall be PG 64-10.

The Asphalt Concrete material used for construction of **all AC Dike and as shown on the plans** shall be paid separately as part of the Hot Mix Asphalt bid item.

Placement of AC Dike includes 6" (CRS 212), 8" (CRS 212), Type D (CT A87B), Type E (CT A87B), or other as directed by the Resident Engineer.

Placing of hot mix asphalt dikes shall conform to Section 39-2.01C(9) of Standard Specification and these Special Provisions.

39-2.01C(9)B Payment

The contract unit bid price paid per linear foot for Asphalt Concrete Dike shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, material (other than Hot mix Asphalt Concrete), tools, and equipment and doing all the work involved in placing and compacting and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 17: Adjust Manhole to Grade. The following special provisions are added a made part hereby:

DIVISION VII DRAINAGE FACILITIES

71 EXISTING DRAINAGE FACILITIES

71-5 ADJUST DRAINAGE STRUCTURES

Add to Section 71-5.01B Frames, Covers, Grates, and Manholes:

ADJUST MANHOLE TO GRADE

Existing Manhole covers (including utility manholes) shall be adjusted to finish grade and new concrete collars poured with materials similar in quality to those in the original structure in accordance with the applicable provisions of Sections 71-5 of the Standard Specifications, the requirements of the owning utility company and these Special Provisions.

Unless otherwise specified by the owners of the facilities, the Contractor shall provide new manhole covers and frames as necessary for the project. The Contractor shall be responsible to coordinate with the owners to obtain the materials approval.

After the structure frame has been removed, the top of the structure shall be carefully trimmed to provide a suitable foundation for the new material.

Steel plates shall be used as necessary and when directed by the Engineer to prevent asphalt and debris from entering the sewer system.

Additionally, a "False Bottom" shall be fabricated and temporarily placed in the manhole cone as a second barrier to prohibit foreign objects from entering the sewer system. Said "false bottom" shall be made from plywood of suitable thickness (3/4" minimum) or stronger material to prohibit heavy objects from breaking the barrier. "False Bottom" shall be fabricated and installed in accordance with the requirements and standards of the owner. The false bottom shall comply with the owning utility company Standard, or as otherwise approved by the Engineer.

After completion of the work, the structure covers, frames, grade rings and old concrete collar debris that were removed from the roadbed shall become the property of the Contractor.

Nothing in these Special Provisions shall relieve the Contractor from his responsibilities as provided in Section 7-1.04, "Public Safety" of the Standard Specifications.

Coordination and communication shall be maintained between the Contractor and the owning utility company.

The Contractor shall adjust to final grade all manhole covers owned by the Coachella Valley Water District.

The adjustment to grade of other manhole covers, such as those owned by phone and electric companies, will be performed by the utility owner.

Water and gas valve covers shall be adjusted by the Contractor as provided elsewhere in these Special Provisions.

Payment:

The contract unit bid price paid per each for Adjust Manhole shall include full compensation for furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, for doing all the work involved including the installation of the concrete ring and no additional compensation will be allowed therefor.

Item 18: Concrete Curb Ramp. The following special provisions are added a made part hereby:

DIVISION VIII MISCELLANEOUS CONSTRUCTION

73 CONCRETE CURBS AND SIDEWALKS

Add to Section 73-1.01 General:

73-1.01 GENERAL

Minor Concrete Items to be constructed are:

Curb Ramps and Spandrels

These minor concrete structures shall be constructed in accordance with the County Road Improvement Standards and Specifications or as directed by the Engineer and in conformance with Section 51, 73 and 90 of Standard Specifications, except as modified.

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 505 pounds per cubic yard for:
Curb Ramps

The cementitious material content of concrete must be at least 590 pounds per cubic yard for:
Spandrels

73-1.03 CONSTRUCTION

Add to Section 73-1.03 Construction:

Preparation of subgrade for the concrete structures shall be done in conformance with the requirements of Section 73-1.03B Subgrade Preparation of the Standard Specifications.

Excess material resulting from the excavation of the subgrade shall be disposed of as provided in Section 00-1.14, 'Disposal Of Excess Excavation Or Materials', of these Special Provisions.

Full compensation for the removal of existing minor concrete structures (Curb Ramps and Spandrels) shall be considered as included in the contract bid prices for such minor concrete structures.

Reconstruction of spandrel shall be included in the work for reconstructing curb ramp.

The Contractor is responsible for meeting requirements of American with Disabilities Act (ADA), the current edition of the California Building Code, and the draft and final versions of the Accessibility Guidelines for Pedestrian Facilities within the Public Right of Way as published by the United States Access Board.

Construction of minor concrete items shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

- 1) Removal and disposal of existing sidewalk, and/or curb and gutter and existing soil and aggregate as required;
- 2) Establishing grades, and assuring that all grades are met;
- 3) Performing all grading and compaction – including all required aggregate import, as directed by the Engineer and in accordance with County Standards;
- 4) Construction of new minor concrete items;

- 5) All scoring/grooving and required saw cutting;
- 6) Repair of existing asphalt and PCC surfacing;
- 7) Installing 1/2" wide expansion joints;
- 8) All landscaping, and related work, to return the area adjacent to the Curb Ramps and Spandrels to its original condition and to conform the area to the new improvements;

At a minimum, the area from the BCR to ECR shall meet all required ADA standards and the latest edition of the California Building Code. Therefore, to conform to existing conditions and/or to achieve the required four-foot level area (as-built maximum of 2.00% crossfall) at the top portion of the curb ramp, it may be necessary to extend the work beyond the BCR/ECR in certain instances.

DETECTABLE WARNING SURFACES (TRUNCATED DOMES)

This work includes installing detectable warning surface on the curb ramps and on other areas requiring installation of detectable warning surface as shown on the plans, standard plans, and as specified in these Special Provisions, and as directed by the Engineer.

Curb ramp detectable warning surface must be:

1. Yellow color complying with Federal Standard 595C, Color No. 33538.
2. Raised truncated domes.

The manufacturer must provide a written 5-year warranty for detectable warning surface, guaranteeing replacement when there is defect in the dome shape, color fastness, sound-on-cane acoustic quality, resilience, or attachment. The warranty period will begin upon acceptance of the contract.

Installation of curb ramp detectable warning surface must comply with the manufacturer's recommendations.
