**BACKGROUND:** Mr. Jennings has been with the Office of the Treasurer-Tax Collector for more than 26 years, serving in numerous capacities. During the last 3 years he served as the Assistant Treasurer-Tax Collector, directing all operational aspects of the department including oversight of the \$8 billion Treasurer's Pooled Investment Fund, 112 employees, 4 locations, an annual budget of approximately \$25 million as well as oversee the collection of \$4 billion dollars in county property taxes.

During his tenure with the office Matthew also achieved several milestones including multi-million dollar increases in annual unsecured collections and implementation of the CREST Property Tax System. He is very active in the California Association of Treasurer-Tax Collectors (CACTAC) serving on multiple committees and assisting in the development of the California State Controller's Property Tax Manual.

Mr. Jennings holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Management from Hope International University and is expected to complete his Master of Public Administration Degree from California Baptist University in August of 2020.

The combined education and experience that Mr. Jennings has acquired more than qualify him to lead the department and fulfill the term of his predecessor. Preserving the fiscal strength of the County is of the utmost importance during these challenging economic times and the appointment of Matthew Jennings will provide a seamless transition in leadership and continuity of this important county elected office.
