BACKGROUND:

Summary

In June of 2017, the California Legislature passed, and the Governor signed into law the Medicinal and Adult-Use Cannabis Regulation and Safety Act (MAUCRSA). Under MAUCRSA, the California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) was designated as the state agency responsible for issuing licenses to commercial cannabis cultivators in California. Temporary licenses issued by CDFA went into effect on January 1, 2018. Under the terms of this agreement, the Agricultural Commissioner's Office will perform cannabis cultivation licensing compliance inspections for CDFA. Inspections will be completed at temporarily licensed cultivation, nursery and processing facilities.

This agreement is authorized by Section 26069.1 of the California Business and Professions Code.

This Amendment No. 1 to Standard Agreement No. 18-0292 extends the termination date of the agreement for an additional twelve (12) months from June 30, 2020 to June 30, 2021.

This amendment was approved as to form by County Counsel.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

On January 15, 2019, Agenda Item 3.1, the Board of Supervisors approved Standard Agreement No. 18-0292 with the California Department of Food and Agriculture for cannabis cultivation compliance inspections in accordance with the Cal Cannabis Program in the amount of \$14,000 for the period of February 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The dollar amount covers all related cost.


