RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:



BACKGROUND:

Summary

On May 1, 2018, agenda item 3.11, the Board approved EMARC-99030-002-06/23, a Service Agreement between the County of Riverside and Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. dba Environmental and Demolition Services Group, for Disaster-Related Debris Management Services through June 30, 2023. On May 22, 2018, agenda item 3.16, the Board approved EMARC-99030-001-06/23, a Service Agreement between the County of Riverside and Tetra Tech, Inc. for Disaster-Related Debris Management Monitoring Services through June 30, 2023.

Both the Agreement with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc, and the Agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc., are usage agreements that shall be activated only in the face of or during an emergency or disaster.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

There is no negative impact on residents or businesses in the County of Riverside. In order to be eligible to recover contract expenses through the FEMA Public Assistance claim reimbursement process, the required contract provisions must be incorporated into each Agreement through the Amendment.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

The Agreement with Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. (EMARC-99030-002-06/23) is a multi-year agreement through June 30, 2023. Ceres Environmental Services, Inc. was chosen in response to RFP EMARC-007 as the most responsive and responsible bid that was reviewed by an evaluation team from the Riverside County Emergency Management Department, Flood Control, and Waste Resources.

The Agreement with Tetra Tech, Inc. (EMARC-99030-001-06/23) is a multi-year agreement through June 30, 2023. Tetra Tech, Inc. was chosen in response to RFP EMARC-006 as the most responsive and responsible bid that was reviewed by an evaluation team from the Riverside County Emergency Management Department, Flood Control, Waste Resources, and Purchasing and Fleet Services.

The Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with Ceres Environmental Services Inc and the Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with Tetra Tech Inc. adds the necessary terms and conditions to comply with required contract provisions. The California Governor's Office of Emergency Services reviewed each Agreement and it was their recommendation that the required contract provisions under 2 C.F.R § 200.326 and 2 C.F.R. Part 200, Appendix II be added to comply with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regulations.

The Service Agreement for Disaster-Related Debris Management Services between County of Riverside (COUNTY) and Ceres Environmental Services, Inc., dba Environmental and Demolition Services Group, (CONTRACTOR), entered into as of May 01, 2018, is amended as follows:

1. Exhibit D (Required Contract Provisions under 2 C.F.R § 200.326 and 2 C.F.R. Part 200, Appendix II) is added to the Agreement.
2. Exhibit E (Certification Regarding Lobbying) is added to the Agreement.
3. Capitalized Terms/Amendment to Prevail. Unless defined herein or the context requires otherwise, all capitalized terms herein shall have the meaning defined in the Agreement, as heretofore amended. The provisions of this Amendment No. 1 shall prevail over any inconsistency or conflicting provisions of the Agreement, as heretofore amended, and shall supplement the remaining provisions thereof.
4. Miscellaneous. Except as amended or modified herein, all the terms of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall apply with the same force and effect. Time is of the essence in this Amendment No. 1 and the Agreement and each and all of their respective provisions. Subject to the provisions of the Agreement as to assignment, the agreements, conditions and provisions herein contained shall apply to and bind the heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns of the parties hereto. If any provisions of this Amendment No. 1 or the Agreement shall be determined to be illegal or unenforceable, such determination shall not affect any other provision of the Agreement and all such other provisions shall remain in full force and effect. The language in all parts of the Agreement shall be construed according to its normal and usual meaning and not strictly for or against either COUNTY or CONTRACTOR.
5. This Amendment No. 1 shall not be binding or consummated until it is fully executed by the Parties.






