### **BACKGROUND:**

# **Summary**

The Riverside County Department of HHPWS/CAP is requesting approval of Resolution No. 2020-166 delegating authority to the Director of the Department of Housing, Homelessness Prevention and Workforce Solutions, by and through its Community Action Partnership, to apply for, accept and administer the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) and the Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program (DOE WAP) Grants received from the State of California Department of Community Services and Development (CSD). These programs were formerly administered by Riverside County Department of Public Health.

The LIHEAP and DOE WAP funding is administered by CSD, and CSD has accountability and monitoring responsibility for these local contracts. CSD distributes LIHEAP and DOE WAP contracts annually to the County of Riverside Community Action Partnership, which previously was part of the Riverside County Department of Public Health, yet now is a part of the Riverside County Department of Housing, Homelessness Prevention and Workforce Solutions. The grant agreements seldom vary significantly from year to year.

Staff recommend adoption of Resolution 2020-166 and County Counsel has approved the resolution as to form.

## Impact on Residents and Businesses

LIHEAP and DOE WAP funds are distributed to the community through Utility Assistance and Weatherization Programs, which offsets or pays for the cost of utilities in homes, and contributes to the overall improvement of energy efficiency, and reduce energy costs for low-income Riverside County residents.

No County General Funds will be required.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING, HOMELESSNESS PREVENTION AND WORKFORCE SOLUTIONS/COMMUNITY ACTION PARTNERSHIP, TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND ADMINISTER THE LOW-INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANTS AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM GRANTS RECEIVED FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY SERVICES AND DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside desires to give the Department of Housing, Homelessness Prevention and Workforce Solutions ("HHPWS"), by and through its Community Action Partnership ("CAP"), responsibility for management and administration of funds and programs related to The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") and The Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program ("DOE WAP") from the State of California Department of Community Services and Development ("CSD"); and

WHEREAS, CSD annually has provided CAP with significant grant funds that must be spent promptly and strictly in accordance with CSD requirements; and

WHEREAS, LIHEAP and DOE WAP Programs assist low income residents of the County of Riverside with weatherizing and updating their home to reduce energy costs and to reduce carbon emissions; and

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate award and acceptance of CSD grants and assure that maximum funds are available for the benefit of County residents.

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND, DETERMINED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, State of California, ("Board"), in regular session assembled on Tuesday, July 07, 2020, at 9:30 a.m., in the meeting room of the Board of Supervisors located on the 1st floor of the County Administrative Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, as follows:

- 1. The Director of HHPWS/CAP, or designee, is authorized to apply for and accept Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") and Department of Energy Weatherization Assistance Program ("DOE WAP") funds on behalf of the County of Riverside. This authority shall include signature of necessary grant acceptance documents, agreements, amendments (that increase or otherwise modify the grant) and related documents required to secure and continue the grant for the County. Agreements and amendments shall be approved as to form by County Counsel.
- 2. The Director of HHPWS/CAP, or designee, shall administer LIHEAP and DOE WAP funds and its related programs and sign all certifications, assurances, exhibits, reports or similar documents made or required under the LIHEAP and DOE WAP.
- 3. The Director of HHPWS/CAP, or designee, shall promptly report to the Board all grants received and grant funding changes for budget and Auditor-Controller purposes. The Director of HHPWS/CAP, or designee, shall also promptly report any material changes or significant new developments related to the LIHEAP and DOE WAP grants.
  - 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
