

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

This Second Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Eastvale modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the deletion of two (2) Deputy Sheriff positions and the addition of two (2) Community Service Officer Positions. On May 27, 2020, the Eastvale Mayor signed the Amendment. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff has recommended budget adjustments that correspond with the additional contract law enforcement services. Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated decrease of \$319,900 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2020-21. The Department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate the addition in expenditures and include them in its FY2020-21 budget.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Eastvale approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.

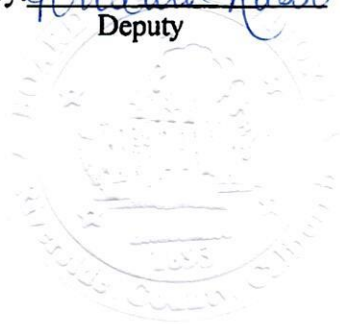
