On motion of Supervisor Washington, seconded by Supervisor Perez and duly carried by unanimous vote, IT WAS ORDERED that the meeting of Tuesday, July 7, 2020 be adjourned in memory of 1st Lt. David Schmitz, a United States Air Force pilot, who passed away in a plane crash on June 30, 2020.

1st Lt. Schmitz received his pilot license at 17 years of age, in pursuit of his lifelong goal of flying for the United States Air Force as a pilot. He started his career in the Air Force as an enlistee, working as a loadmaster aboard mammoth C-17 Globemaster cargo planes.

He earned his commission through officer training school and graduated at the top of his class in pilot training. 1st Lt. Schmitz served as assistant mobility chief for the 77th Fighter Squadron at Shaw Air force Base in South Carolina.

1st Lt. Schmitz' memory and passionate spirit will live forever in the hearts of those who knew and loved him. He will be greatly missed but never forgotten.

The Board of Supervisors commemorates his service to the County of Riverside.
