**BACKGROUND:**

On August 12, 2020, the Riverside County Grand Jury issued their report on KPMG and the County Transformation Project. Within the report, there are multiple findings and recommendations to the Board of Supervisors and county staff.

If approved by the Board today, the formation of an Ad Hoc Committee, comprised of two county Supervisors, will work with and direct staff to prepare the response. A response is required to be filed with the Presiding Judge, the Grand Jury and the Riverside County Clerk-Recorder within 90 days. In order to meet the statutory deadline, the response must be approved by the Board of Supervisors no later than the November 10 agenda date.
