BACKGROUND:

Summary

This Second Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with the City of Norco modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the deletion of one (1) Deputy Sheriff position and the addition of one (1) Community Service Officer position. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated decrease of \$408,700 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2020-21. The Department has included the cost estimate in its budget; therefore, no budget adjustment is necessary.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of Norco approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
