BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Limonite Avenue and Interstate 15 Interchange improvement project, in the Cities of Eastvale and Jurupa Valley, has improved safety and traffic operations for residents and visitors to these communities. The new interchange ramps and the new Limonite Avenue Bridge over Interstate 15 were opened to traffic in November of 2019.

The Cajalco Safety project in the community of Mead Valley is currently under construction and is expected to be complete in the fall of 2020. The safety improvements include the addition of a continuous center turn pocket, bus turnouts, wider shoulders, and intersection improvements at Brown and Clark Streets, and a new signal at Day Street. These improvements will improve safety for residents and commuters that travel on Cajalco Road.

Both of these projects required the acquisition of property to construct the needed public improvements. The County of Riverside has obtained possession of the needed properties for the projects, through the eminent domain process, which has allowed both projects to proceed to construction; however due to the complex legal issues arising from the acquisition of the properties, legal counsel and services are required. We have been able to successfully negotiate a settlement with 36 of the 39 property owners impacted, but still have 3 outstanding. Good faith negotiations by staff continues as we strive to reach a settlement.

On July 11, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.55, a Legal Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys at Law, for legal counsel and services in the amount of \$100,000, for the Limonite Interchange and Cajalco Road Safety projects.

On June 26, 2018, the Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.63, Amendment No. 1 to the Legal Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys at Law for a time extension through April 30, 2020, and to increase the contract amount to \$375,000 for legal counsel and services for the Limonite Interchange and Cajalco Road Safety projects.

On May 7, 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved Agenda Item 3.25, Amendment No. 2 to the Legal Services Agreement between the County of Riverside and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys

at Law for a time extension through December 31, 2020 and to increase the contract amount to \$525,000 for legal counsel and services for the Limonite Interchange and Cajalco Safety projects.

The Limonite Interchange project is subject to litigation relating to acquisition of the properties that were within the sphere of the project. The legal services between the County and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys at Law provides legal services necessary and appropriate to the defense and/or settlement of litigation brought against the County by this owner.

The Cajalco Safety project required the acquisition of 31 of the total 39 properties that needed to be acquired for these two projects. The County continues to negotiate a final settlement agreement and County Counsel is taking the lead on these negotiations.

Amendment No. 3 to the Legal Services Agreement increases the total compensation to \$775,000 and provides a time extension through December 31, 2021.

County Counsel has approved the Agreement as to form.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The project improvements along Cajalco Road and within the Limonite Interchange will improve the safety and operation of the road for vehicles and pedestrians.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

This amendment would increase the Legal Services Agreement by \$250,000. The total amount expended in FY 17/18, FY 18/19, and FY 19/20 was \$525,000. Mira Loma Road and Bridge Benefit District funds will be used for these services. No general funds will be used.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Given the complexity of the cases, and the savings to the public realized through a negotiated settlement of the majority of the cases, the legal costs are appropriate.

AMENDMENT No. 3

Amendment to Agreement Between

The County of Riverside and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys at Law

THIS AMENDMENT to a Legal Services Agreement is made and entered into as of this 25TH day of August 2020, by and between the County of Riverside, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter the "COUNTY"), and Murphy & Evertz, Attorneys at Law (hereinafter "ATTORNEYS").

RECITALS

- A. COUNTY and ATTORNEYS have entered in an agreement entitled "LEGAL SERVICES AGREEMENT" that is dated July 11, 2017 (hereinafter the "Agreement"). The Agreement provides the terms and conditions, statement of services and budget for the performance of legal services related to all aspects of the Cajalco Road Interim Safety Project and the Limonite Interchange Project (hereinafter "PROJECTS") and any condemnation and/or inverse condemnation actions associated with these projects.
- B. COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into Amendment No. 1 of contract on June 26, 2018, providing a time extension through April 30, 2020 and additional compensation in the amount of \$275,000.
- C. COUNTY and ATTORNEYS entered into Amendment No. 2 of contract on May 7, 2019, providing a time through December 31, 2020 and additional compensation from the amount of \$375,000 to the amount of \$525,000.
- D. The extent of support services needed to obtain the properties required for the PROJECTS has exceeded the amount of support that was anticipated.
- E. The parties desire to amend the Agreement to provide additional budget needed to perform additional services required to complete the procurement of the properties needed for the PROJECTS.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The total amount of compensation paid to ATTORNEYS is hereby increased from \$525,000 to \$775,000.
- 2. Extend the termination date of the agreement from December 31, 2020 to December 31, 2021.
- ATTORNEYS shall perform additional legal services in support of COUNTY's effort to acquire properties needed for PROJECTS.
- 4. Except to the extent specifically modified or amended hereunder, all of the terms, covenants and conditions

of the Agreement and Amendment 2 shall remain in full force and effect between the parties hereto.

IN WITNESS HEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Amendment to the Agreement to be duly executed this day and year first written above.
