[\$373,930 Total, \$5,500 Ongoing - Local Funds 100%] (Clerk to Advertise)

**RECOMMENDED MOTION:** That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Find that the Traffic Signal at the Intersection of Briggs Road and Evening Glow Drive Project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities;
2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of Briggs Road and Evening Glow Drive in the Community of French Valley;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 16, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The County of Riverside Transportation Department is proposing to install a new traffic signal and safety lighting at the intersection of Briggs Road and Evening Glow Drive in the Community of French Valley area of Riverside County.

The proposed traffic signal improvements include the installation of new traffic signal poles and mast-arms, safety lights, traffic signal cabinets, a battery backup system, underground conduits and wiring, pull boxes, foundations, radar/video detection system for signal operation, wireless radio communication system, new striping, new traffic signs, minor asphalt concrete pavement patching, removing and reconstructing curb ramps, and other associated work as directed by the Engineer.

The new signal is expected to improve safety and construction will begin in the fall of 2020.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

**Environmental Findings**

The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Briggs Rd and Evening Glow Dr. This safety improvement project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The proposed traffic signal will improve traffic safety by providing controlled traffic movements.

The work is scheduled to begin in the Fall of 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

**Additional Fiscal Information**

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$373,930 and will be funded with Western County DIF Signal Mitigation Funds. The Development Impact Fee (DIF) program, which is governed under Ordinance 659, allows for the use of DIF funds for traffic signal facilities.

Annual traffic signal operation and maintenance costs are estimated at \$5,500 to be funded from gas tax.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Riverside County Transportation Department proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Briggs Rd and Evening Glow Dr. in the Murrieta area of Riverside County. Briggs Rd is a five-lane facility that travels in the North-South directions. Inside through lanes are 11' wide and outside through lanes are 20' wide. Parking is allowed adjacent to the existing curb, gutter, and sidewalk. Evening Glow Dr. is a two-lane facility that travels in the East-West directions with 23-foot wide through lanes and curb, gutter, and sidewalk. The project will include striping of the roadway starting at the intersection of Briggs Rd and Evening Glow Dr. The striping is limited to approximate 900' to the north, 80' to the west, 700' to the south, and 500' to the east.

The proposed project will also include the following:

- Installing traffic signal poles, mastarms, signal cabinets, and pullboxes
- Remove/install traffic signs

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

Improvements will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County Multiple Species Habitat Conservation Plan (MSHCP). The project is inside a cell criteria area. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity outside of cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance and therefore is a covered activity. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

**The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:**

**Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities** – The project proposes to install a traffic signal at the intersection of Briggs Rd and Evening Glow Dr. This safety improvement project is exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because it does not create additional traffic lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

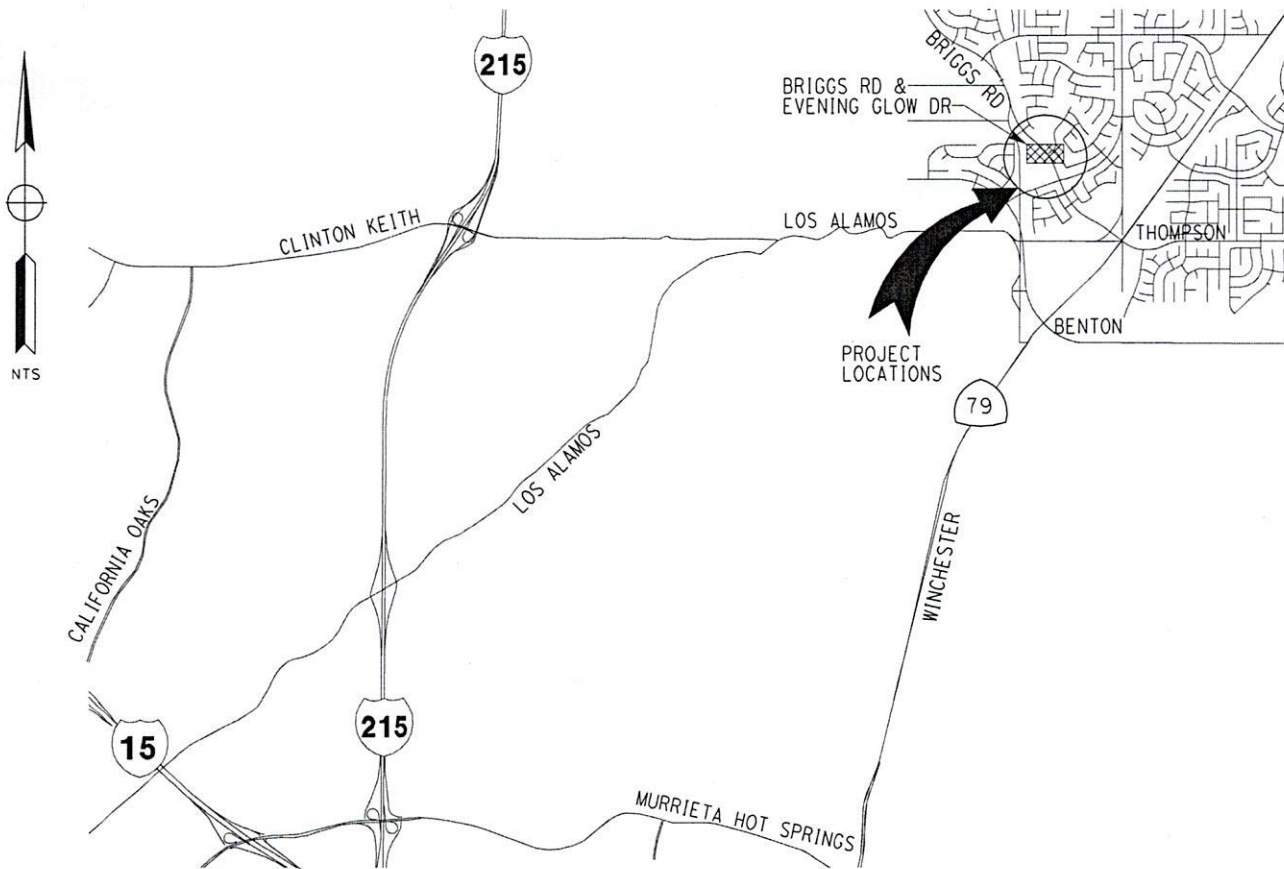
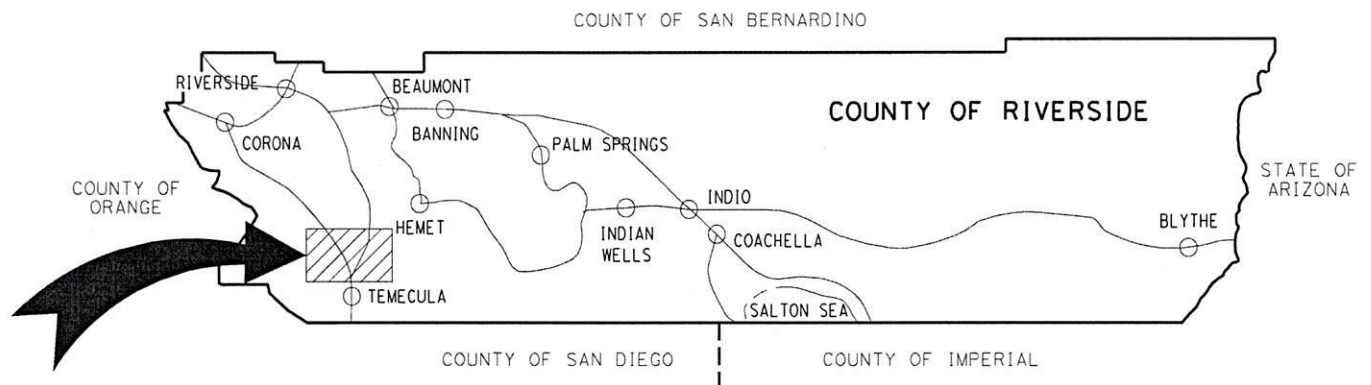
