BACKGROUND:

Summary

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution No. 2020-092 adopted June 30, 2020, the Board of Supervisors gave notice of a public hearing for August 25, 2020, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 136 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Street Lighting Zone 136 will fund the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public rights-of-way located east of Harrison Avenue and north of Airport Boulevard in the Thermal area and includes one commercial parcel totalling 9.31 acres.

The annexation of territory to an existing assessment district formed under the Landscaping and Lighting Act is a change of organization that requires a public hearing as part of the annexation process. Str. & H. Code §§ 22605(a), 22607, 22588; Gov't. Code § 53753(d).

On July 1, 2020, a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2020-092 was mailed to all property owners within Street Lighting Zone 136, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2020-092 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of Resolution No. 2020-092 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new assessment is for the purpose of providing the maintenance and servicing of streetlights within public right-of-way.

Only the commercial property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 136, which are represented by Parcel Map No. 37562, as described in the attached Exhibit "A" (a two-page exhibit containing a description and diagram) are impacted by the cost

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of this annexation. The property owners within the proposed boundaries of Street Lighting Zone 136 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (streetlights).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-22 for Street Lighting Zone 136 is \$655.00. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2021-22 within Street Lighting Zone 136 of \$71.00 per acre. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers for electricity (CPI-U), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2021.
