BACKGROUND:

Summary

Pursuant to the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972 and Resolution No. 2020-098 adopted June 30, 2020, the Board of Supervisors gave notice of a public hearing for August 25, 2020, to receive testimony regarding the Annexation of Zone 206 to Landscaping and Lighting Maintenance District No. 89-1-Consolidated (L&LMD No. 89-1-C). Annexation of Zone 206 will fund the maintenance and servicing of streetlights and dormant parkway landscaping within public rights-of-way located northeast of Interstate 215, west of I-215 Frontage Road and south of Alessandro Boulevard in the March Air Reserve area and includes 2 commercial parcels totalling 39.42 acres.

The annexation of territory to an existing assessment district formed under the Landscaping and Lighting Act is a change of organization that requires a public hearing as part of the annexation process. Str. & H. Code §§ 22605(a), 22607, 22588; Gov't. Code § 53753(d).

On July 1, 2020, a notice of the public hearing and information sheet, a mail-in ballot, an impartial analysis, and a copy of Resolution No. 2020-098 was mailed to all property owners within Zone 206, proposed for annexation to L&LMD No. 89-1-C. Pursuant to the notice, all ballots must be returned prior to the conclusion of the public hearing.

Notice of the public hearing was also given by publication of a certified copy of Resolution No. 2020-098 in an appropriate newspaper at least ten (10) days prior to the public hearing date and by posting a certified copy of Resolution No. 2020-098 on the official bulletin board customarily used by the Board of Supervisors for the posting of notices and in two (2) other public locations within the County.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The new assessment is for the purpose of providing the maintenance and servicing of streetlights and dormant parkway landscaping within public right-of-way.

Only the commercial property owners within the proposed boundaries of Zone 206, which are represented by Improvement Plan No. 180043, as described in the attached Exhibit "A" (a two-

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page exhibit containing a description and diagram) are impacted by the cost of this annexation. The property owners within the proposed boundaries of Zone 206 have petitioned the County of Riverside to annex their property to L&LMD No. 89-1-C and understand that this annexation will result in an assessment on their property to fund the maintenance and servicing of the aforementioned improvements (streetlights and dormant parkway landscaping).

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

The proposed budget for fiscal year 2021-22 for Zone 206 is \$2,687.00. This will result in an assessment for fiscal year 2021-22 within Zone 206 of \$68.00 per acre. The annual assessment may be adjusted annually by the greater of 2% or the cumulative percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for all Urban Consumers (CPI-U), if any, as it stands as of March of each year over the base index for March of 2021.


DESCRIPTION OF BOUNDARIES
