BACKGROUND:

Summary

On September 15, 2020, the Board of Supervisors approved agenda item 3.2 the introduction of Ordinance No 960 to increase the Civil Grand Jury fee from \$25 to \$60 per day. Penal Code section 890 states that any changes to the Civil Grand Jury fee must be done by ordinance.

Today's action on this agenda item adopting Ordinance No. 960 will finalize the Board's approval of the increased Civil Grand Jury fees. Once the ordinance is adopted, it becomes effective thirty days later.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

Civil grand juries provide an important oversight to local government. They help to ensure that local governments are run more efficiently and ethically. Being a member of the civil grand jury offers the opportunity to be informed in depth on local government while serving the community.

Additional Fiscal Information

The cost of this adjustment was included in the department's adopted budget for the current fiscal year and no additional funding is being requested.


