2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Pala Road Resurfacing Project in the Community of Wolf Valley;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, October 14, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

**BACKGROUND:**

**Summary**

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for resurfacing approximately 1.7 miles of Pala Road from South of Pechanga Road to the San Diego County Line in the Community of Wolf Valley of Riverside County.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the poor deteriorated condition of the road. The proposed project will include removing the existing asphalt concrete pavement and overlaying it with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA). Some portions of Pala Road are so extremely deteriorated that the road will be completely excavated and then reconstructed back to existing grade with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and a Class 2 Aggregate Base.

Additional improvements include placement of AC dike, construction of pavement safety edge and shoulder backing, replacement of an existing culvert, construction of asphalt concrete drains, installation of guardrail, traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Pala Road resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid received.

The improvements to Pala Road are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

**Impact on Citizens and Businesses**

The Roadway resurfacing on Pala Road will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in January of 2021 and take two months to complete. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The County of Riverside Transportation Department proposes to resurface approximately 1.7 miles of Pala Road from 105 feet south of Pechanga Road to the County of San Diego border line. Pala Road is classified as a Collector in the County of Riverside General Plan. Pala Road ranges from 24-34 feet in width with dike and over-side drains along various segments of the roadway. The proposed project will include:

- Removing and pulverizing the roadway followed by overlaying with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
- Excavating to native material and reconstructing back to existing grade with HMA at some segments of Pala Road
- Pulverizing and overlaying of dirt shoulder to maintain safe roadway widths
- Constructing dike
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvaging/removing and installing new signs
- Installing guardrail systems along some segments of Pala Road
- Adjusting drop inlet to grade
- Removing and replacing existing culverts in kind
- Modifying existing headwalls
- Reconstructing existing AC and concrete driveways
- Constructing AC driveways in existing dirt driveway locations
- Installing traffic detector loops
- Utility adjustment/relocation

**ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:**

The proposed project will be constructed within existing County right of way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements. The project improvements will raise the existing roadway profile by 0.40 feet.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside County MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.3.4 of the Western Riverside County MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project is within a cell criteria area and is considered to be a safety improvement project under operation and maintenance, therefore it is a covered activity under the Western Riverside County MSHCP. The project will comply with the construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

If tree and/or vegetation removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season (March 1 – September 1), a preconstruction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

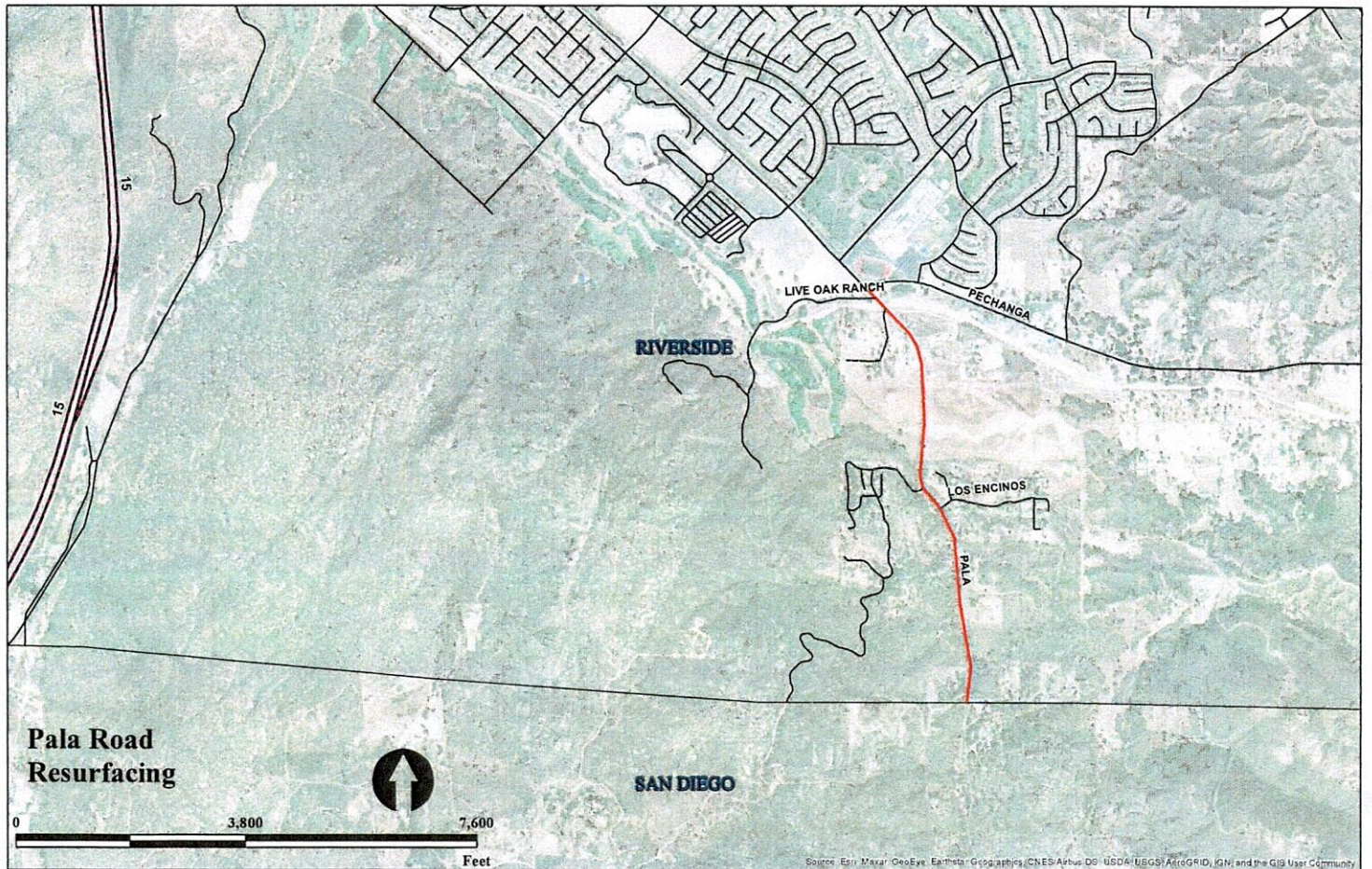
**The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:**

**Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities** – The project proposes to resurface Pala Road, place safety edge and shoulder backing, replace existing culverts in-kind, install guardrail and traffic deter loops, modify existing headwalls, and pulverize and overlay dirt shoulders. Additionally, the project will include minor safety improvements such as installation of new signs and striping of the roads. The proposed activities are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional traffic lanes and involve negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.
