# BACKGROUND:

### <u>Summary</u>

The Political Reform Act prohibits a public official from using his or her position to influence a government decision in which he or she has a financial interest. Government Code section 87300 requires local government agencies to adopt and promulgate a Conflict of Interest Code identifying officials and employees required to file statements of economic interest based on the positions they hold. A local government agency, as defined by Government Code section 82041, includes the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO").

Each even-numbered year, Government Code section 87306.5 requires local government agencies to review their Conflict of Interest Code, make appropriate revisions, if necessary, and submit an amended Conflict of Interest Code to the code reviewing body. Government Code section 82011(b) identifies the Board of Supervisors for the County of Riverside as the code reviewing body for a local government agency within its county.

LAFCO recently adopted Resolution No. 12-20 amending its Conflict of Interest Code on July 23, 2020 to include new positions. LAFCO has submitted its amended Conflict of Interest Code for approval by the Board of Supervisors as the code reviewing body.

This office has reviewed the amended Conflict of Interest Code of LAFCO and has found that it complies with statutory requirements. A complete copy of the Conflict of Interest Code of LAFCO is attached.

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the amended Conflict of Interest Code of LAFCO, and direct the Clerk of the Board to notify LAFCO of the action taken.

# ADOPTING A CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE RIVERSIDE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

6 WHEREAS, the Political Reform Act ("Act"), Government Code Section 81000 et seq.,
7 requires that state and local government agencies adopt and promulgate Conflict of Interest Codes;
8 and

9 WHEREAS, the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO") adopted a
10 Conflict of Interest Code on May 24, 1990; and

WHEREAS, the current LAFCO Conflict of Interest Code has not been amended since
November 10, 2016; and

WHEREAS, 2 California Code of Regulations ("Regulations") section 18730, contains the
terms of a Standard Conflict of Interest Code which may be incorporated by reference and may be
amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Act; and
WHEREAS, Government Code section 87306.5 requires that a Conflict of Interest Code be

17 reviewed each even numbered year to determine if it is accurate or requires amendment; and

WHEREAS, subsequent amendments to and changes in the Act and Regulations of the Fair
Political Practices Commission by the Legislature and changed circumstances within LAFCO have
made it advisable and necessary, pursuant to Government Code sections 87306 and 87307 of the
Act, to amend and update LAFCO's Conflict of Interest Code; and

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place of a public hearing before LAFCO on the proposed
 amended Conflict of Interest Code was publicly posted for review at the County Administrative
 Center, 4080 Lemon Street, Riverside, California, and was duly published in a newspaper of general
 circulation in the County pursuant to Government Code section 6061; and

WHEREAS, the proposed amended Conflict of Interest Code was considered at a regular
meeting of LAFCO on July 23, 2020, at which all present were given an opportunity to be heard on
the proposed adoption of the amended Conflict of Interest Code;

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NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Riverside Local Agency Formation 1 2 Commission, in regular session assembled on July 23, 2020, that the provisions of 2 California Code 3 of Regulations section 18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated by reference and along with the attached Appendices in which 4 5 certain enumerated officials and employees are designated and disclosure categories are established 6 shall constitute the Conflict of Interest Code for LAFCO.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to section (b)(4) of the Standard Conflict of 8 Interest Code set forth in 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, all designated employees 9 shall file their Statements of Economic Interest with LAFCO's Executive Officer. Upon receipt of 10 the Statements of Economic Interest, the Executive Officer shall retain the Statements of Economic Interest on file with his or her own office, with the exception of the Statement of Economic Interest 11 12 of the Executive Officer who shall file his or her own Statement of Economic Interest with the Clerk 13 of the Board of Supervisors. Statements shall be filed by April 1 of each year to reflect interest held 14 in the prior calendar year.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution and its attached Appendices now 16 supersede Resolution No. 08-16 previously adopting a Conflict of Interest Code for the Riverside 17 Local Agency Formation Commission.

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# CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE RIVERSIDE LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION

(Amended and Restated July 23, 2020)

The Political Reform Act (Government Code section 81000 ct seq.) requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, set forth in 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code, which can be incorporated by reference in an agency's code. After public notice and hearing it may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission, are hereby incorporated by reference. This incorporation page, 2 California Code of Regulations section 18730, and the attached Appendices designating positions and establishing disclosure categories, shall constitute the Conflict of Interest Code of the Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO").

All officials and designated positions required to submit a statement of economic interests shall file their statements with the Executive Officer as LAFCO's Filing Officer. The Executive Officer shall make and retain a copy of all statements filed by Members of LAFCO and the other LAFCO Officials filing under Government Code section 87200, including the Executive Director, and forward the originals of such statements to the Clerk of the Board of the Supervisors of the County of Riverside. The Executive Officer shall retain the originals of the statements filed by all other officials and designated positions and make all statements available for public inspection and reproduction during regular business hours (Government Code section 81008.)

\*<u>Consultants</u> shall disclose to the broadest category in this Code subject to the following limitations:

The Executive Officer may determine in writing that a particular, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and this is not required to comply fully with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant duties and, based upon the description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Officer's determination shall be made a public record and shall be retained for inspection in the same manner and location as other disclosures.

# APPENDIX B

# DISCLOSURE CATEGORIES

The disclosure categories for property and outside business positions, which are established, appear below:

<u>CATEGORY 1</u>: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, all business entities that do business or own real property in Riverside County, plan to do business or own real property in Riverside County within the next year or have done business or owned real property in the County within the past two (2) years.

<u>CATEGORY 2</u>: All interests in real property, which is located in whole or in part within, or not more than two (2) miles outside, the boundaries of Riverside County.

<u>CATEGORY 3</u>: All investments in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entities that are engaged in land development, construction or the acquisition or sale of real property in Riverside County, plan to engage in such activities in the County within the next year or have engaged in such activities in the County within the past two (2) years.

<u>CATEGORY 4</u>: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business that are banking, savings and loan or other financial institutions.

<u>CATEGORY 5</u>: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entities that provide services, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of a type purchased or leased by Riverside Local Agency Formation Commission.

<u>CATEGORY 6</u>: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entities that provide service, supplies, materials, machinery or equipment of a type used or administered or proposed to be acquired by, leased by, used by or administered by the designated employee's department or reviewed, commented upon or recommended by the designated member's Board, Commission, Committee or Council.

<u>CATEGORY 7</u>: All investments and business positions in, and sources of income (including gifts, loans and travel payments) from, business entities subject to review regulation, permitting or licensing authority of the designated employee's department, or designated member's Board, Commission, Committee or Council or which will be subject to such authority within the next year or have been subject to such authority within the past two (2) years.
