

**Summary**

The attached 2019 AMR Annual Performance Report summarizes the fourth full year of operation under the agreement #15-097 for ground ALS emergency ambulance services. AMR has successfully met all performance targets required to earn the fourth one-year extension to add an additional year to the agreement, through June 30, 2024.

As authorized per agenda item 3-8 (January 13, 2015), the County Purchasing agent signed the 4<sup>th</sup> amendment to extend the agreement.

**Impact on Residents and Businesses**

The residents of Riverside County require the services supplied by an efficient EMS system. The ALS emergency ambulance agreement will continue improvements to the County EMS plan designed to optimize emergency medical care to residents thereby minimizing morbidity and mortality from acute illnesses and traumatic injuries.
