3. Approve the project proposed budget as shown on Attachment "A".



BACKGROUND:

Summary

By Minute Order dated June 23, 2020 (Agenda Item 3.35), the Board of Supervisors authorized the Clerk of the Board to advertise for the construction of the Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction Project, Mesa Drive Resurfacing Project, and Hobson Way Resurfacing Project, in the Communities of River Valley, Mesa Verde and East Blythe of eastern Riverside County.

The following road limits are included in the contract:

Road Name	Begin		End	Road Segment Length
Lovekin Boulevard	Seeley Avenue	to	4,400 feet north of Seeley Avenue	0.85 miles
Mesa Drive	Bellwood Drive	to	Black Rock Road/ Hobson Way	0.25 miles
Hobson Way	Florence Boulevard (West)	to	2,680 feet east of De Frain Boulevard	1.2 miles

The three roads were combined to bid as one project in order to gain efficiencies by eliminating multiple bidding and administrative procedures, and to seek more favorable bid costs associated with larger bid quantities.

Roadway resurfacing or reconstruction is needed for the roadway segments noted above due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The Lovekin Boulevard segment will be reconstructed and the Hobson Way and Mesa Drive segments will be resurfaced, with new asphalt concrete pavement. Shoulder backing material will be placed along the shoulders to prevent the outside edge of pavement from cracking and to prevent pavement edge deterioration.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of driveways, curb ramp, asphalt concrete dike, installation of traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs and other associated work.

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On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The Lovekin Boulevard reconstruction, Mesa Drive resurfacing, and Hobson Way resurfacing projects are three of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The contract includes the following schedules of work:

Base Bid 1:	Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction and associated road improvements
Base Bid 2:	Mesa Drive Resurfacing and associated road improvements
Base Bid 3:	Hobson Way Resurfacing and associated road improvements
Alternative Bid 1:	Hobson Way Resurfacing – City of Blythe Portion

The Alternative Bid Schedule 1 includes the portion of Hobson Way resurfacing within City of Blythe (City), and the City has concurred with the bid prices proposed by Hardy & Harper, Inc. The reimbursement Agreement between the City and County will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors for approval concurrent with the award of the construction contract.

The contractor is qualified to perform the work as outlined in the bid, has executed the contract, and has provided bond documents which meet the requirements of the Contract.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate deteriorated segments of Lovekin Boulevard, Mesa Drive, and Hobson Way, totaling approximately two miles, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin in late fall of 2020. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

SUPPLEMENTAL:

Additional Fiscal Information

Construction is expected to be completed in FY 2020/2021 and will be funded with Gas Tax/SB1 funds and City of Blythe.

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The proposed budget, as shown on Attachment "A", includes the contract award amount and other associated costs.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

Contract History and Price Reasonableness

Two (2) bids were received ranging from \$2,811,000 to \$3,124,993. The basis for the selection of a bid is the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

All received bids were responsive to the bidding requirements set forth for the project. The lowest responsible bid was submitted by Hardy and Harper, Inc. in the amount of \$2,811,000 which is \$159,540 (5.4%) below the Engineer's Estimate.

The Transportation Department recommends the award of the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible contractor, Hardy and Harper, Inc. for a total amount of \$2,811,000.

The undersigned, Contractor, having carefully examined the site and the Contract Documents for the construction of Lovekin Boulevard Reconstruction Project, Seeley Avenue to 4,400 feet north of Seeley Avenue; and Mesa Drive Resurfacing Project, Bellwood Drive to Black Rock Road / Hobson Way; and Hobson Way Resurfacing Project, Florence Boulevard (West) to 2,680 feet east of De Frain Boulevard, Communities of River Valley, Mesa Verde, and East Blythe; Project No. C1-0493, C1-0618, D0-0075 hereby proposes to construct the work in accordance with the Contract Documents, including **Addenda Number(s)** 019 (Fill in addenda numbers if addenda have been issued.) for the amount stated in this Bid.

By submitting this Bid, Contractor agrees with County:

1. That unless withdrawn in person by Contractor or some person authorized in writing by Contractor (not by telephone or facsimile) before the time specified in the Notice Inviting Bids for the public opening of bids, this Bid constitutes an irrevocable offer for 90 calendar days after that date.
2. County has the right to reject any or all Bids and to waive any irregularities or informalities contained in a Bid.
3. To execute the Contract and deliver the Performance Bond, Payment Bond and Insurance Certificate with endorsements, that comply with the requirements set forth in the Instruction to Bidders and General Conditions, within ten (10) business days of the date of the Notice of Acceptance of Bid and Intent to Award as issued by the County.
4. That the contract shall be awarded upon a resolution or minute order to that effect duly adopted by the governing body of County; and that execution of the Contract shall constitute a written memorial thereof.
5. To submit to the County such information as County may require determining whether a particular Bid is the lowest responsible bid submitted.
6. That the accompanying Bid Bond, certified check or cashier's check is in an amount not less than 10% of the total bid submitted and constitutes a guarantee that if awarded the contract, Contractor will execute the Contract and deliver the required bonds within ten (10) business days after notice of award. If Contractor fails to execute and deliver said documents, the bond or check is to be charged with the costs of the resultant damages to the County, including but not limited to: publication costs, the difference in money between the amount bid and the amount in excess of the bid which it costs County to do or cause to be done for the work involved, lease and rental costs, additional salaries and overhead, increased interest and costs of funding the project, attorney expense, additional engineering and architectural expense and cost of maintaining or constructing alternate facilities occasioned by the failure to execute and deliver said documents.
