BACKGROUND:

Summary

Pinyon Pines County Water District ("the District") is a small special district. The cost of the annual audit is expensive for a small district and continues to increase. For this reason, the Board of Directors of the District has considered the issue and seeks to change to biennial audits instead of annual audits. The District has calculated that biennial audits will potentially save the District more than \$3,000 every two years. With an operating income of under \$48,000, this is a substantial amount of money for the District. The District's audits in the last five years have all been unqualified audit opinions.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 26909(b)(3), a special district such as the Pinyon Pines County Water District may, by unanimous request of its Board of Directors and with the unanimous approval of the County Board of Supervisors, replace the annual audit requirement with an audit conducted at specific intervals, as recommended by the County Auditor, to be completed at least once every five years.

The Pinyon Pines County Water District Board of Directors proposes replacing the District's annual audits with biennial audits.

Subject to the County Board of Supervisor's unanimous approval, on September 13, 2020, the District's Board of Directors unanimously approved Resolution #117, Resolution of the Board of Directors of the Pinyon Pines County Water District, Superseding Resolution #115 and Approving Biennial Audits Starting with Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2019, to replace the annual audit requirement with a biennial audit and to request the Board of Supervisor's approval of the same.

The District has communicated with the Office of County Auditor-Controller regarding this proposal, and, on October 13, 2020, the Office of County Auditor-Controller confirmed that it approves of the District's moving to biennial financial statement audits. The District requests that the Board of Supervisors unanimously approve the replacement of the District's annual audit requirement as specified above.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE APPROVING THE PINYON PINES COUNTY WATER DISTRICT'S REQUEST TO REPLACE THE ANNUAL AUDIT PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 26909 WITH A BIENNIAL AUDIT REQUIREMENT

WHEREAS, the Pinyon Pines County Water District ("the District") is a California special district established in 1969 and located entirely within the County of Riverside ("County"); and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Government Code section 26909, the District gets prepared an annual audit of its accounts and records, which are provided to the County Auditor-Controller; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code section 26909(b)(3), a special district such as the District may, by unanimous request of the governing board of the special district and with unanimous approval of the County Board of Supervisors, replace the annual audit required under Government Code section 26909 with an audit conducted at specific intervals, as recommended by the County auditor, to be completed at least once every five years; and

WHEREAS, the District has five consecutive years of unqualified audit opinions; and WHEREAS, the audits are expensive, and their costs have continued to increase over time:

WHEREAS, biennial audits will potentially save the District more than \$3,000 every two years, and, with an operating income under \$48,000, this is a substantial amount of money for the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Pinyon County Water District ("Board of Directors") therefore proposes preparing and providing the County Auditor-Controller, and any other agency requiring such information, with an audit to take place biennially; and

WHEREAS, the District has communicated with the Office of the County Auditor-Controller about the proposal, and the County Auditor-Controller's office approves of this change; and

WHEREAS, in the event the County Auditor-Controller expresses concerns regarding issues within the compilations or finds anomalies of financial concerns with the submitted records at any time.
