Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 2, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for approximately 0.25 mile of roadway resurfacing at Camino Aventura from Bubbling Wells Road to Approximately 1285 Feet Easterly, in the Community of Desert Hot Springs of Riverside County.

Camino Aventura is a 64 foot wide local road with curb and gutter on both sides. Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. The proposed project will include removing approximately 0.25 mile of existing asphalt concrete pavement followed by repaving with Hot Mix Asphalt Concrete.

Additional improvements include reconstruction of concrete cross gutter, curb and gutter, relocation of existing irrigation lines, traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, replacement of existing traffic signs and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County TIP. The Camino Aventura resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use with the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid received.

Environmental Findings

The improvements to Camino Aventura are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because they do not create additional automobile lanes and involves negligible or no expansion of existing or former use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate a deteriorated segment of Camino Aventura, totaling approximately 0.25 mile, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is anticipated to begin in February 2021 and will be completed within one month. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible.

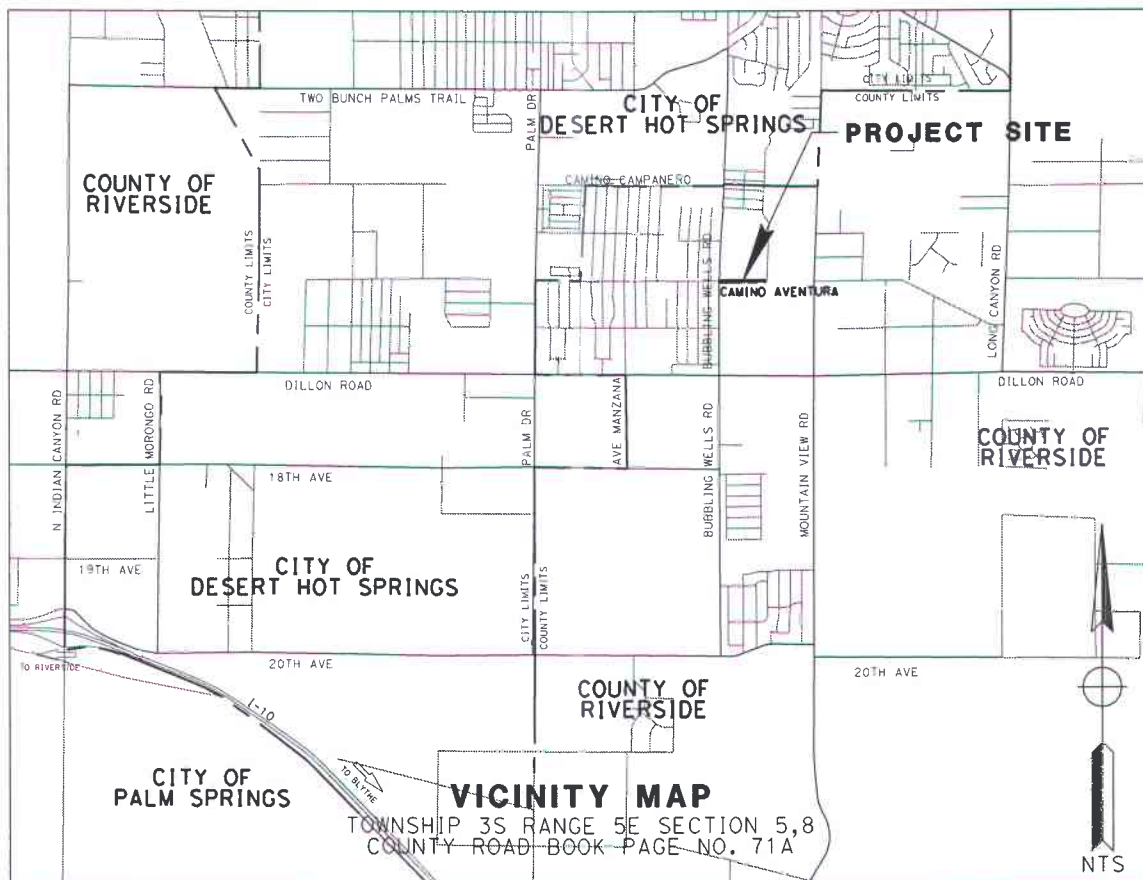
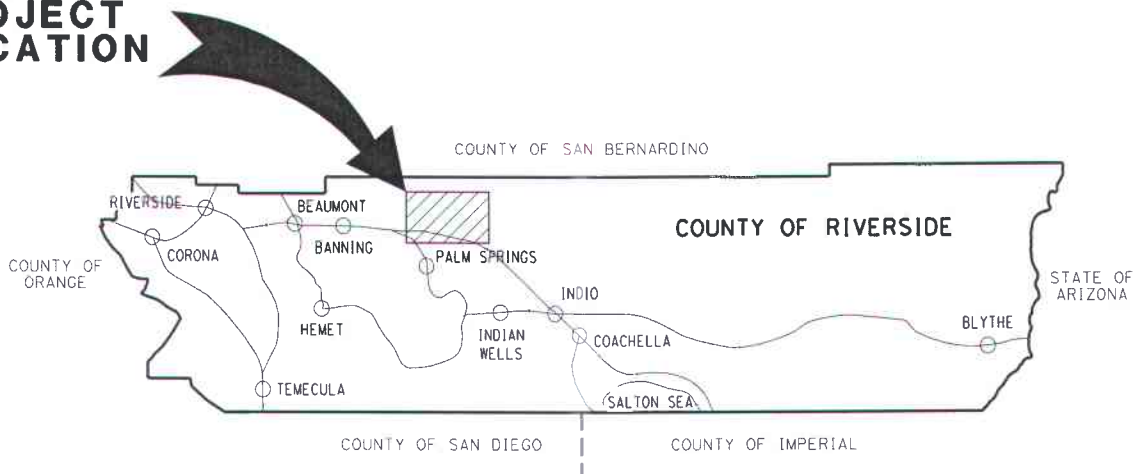

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department is proposing to resurface approximately 1,285 feet of Camino Aventura from Bubbling Wells Road to approximately 1,285 feet east of Bubbling Wells Road. Camino Aventura is classified in the County of Riverside's General Plan as a Local Road. Camino Aventura is a two lane road and is currently 64 feet wide with curb and gutter along both sides of the roadway.

The project will include the following:

- Removing the existing roadway
- Pave with hot mix asphalt (HMA)
- Reconstruction of concrete cross gutter and spandrel
- Reconstruction of concrete curb and gutter
- Utility adjustments
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs
- Remove and Replace Barricade

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will not acquire right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing roadways are considered a covered activity. If tree removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season from February 15th to August 15th, a pre-construction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).



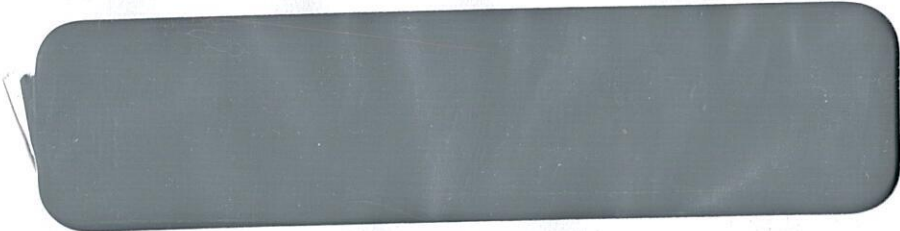
