

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Riverside County Transportation and Land Management Agency is dedicated to integrating transportation and land use functions in order to enhance the quality of life in Riverside communities. The Agency achieves this by properly planning new communities to accommodate growth in a balanced way while being good stewards of the environment and natural resources. The Agency is comprised of various departments and unique divisions including Administrative Services, Aviation, Salton Sea Authority, Building & Safety, Code Enforcement, Planning and Transportation.

The Human Resources Classification and Compensation Unit received a request from the Transportation and Land Management Agency to designate their Deputy Director of Natural Resources job classification At-Will. The At-Will designation is supported for this mission critical and highly political role as it provides the needed oversight for the Salton Sea Authority operations. This position is currently vacant. This request is only to designate the classification as At-Will and no salary changes are needed.
