

3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 9, 2020 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.



BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Department proposes to resurface three segments of Varner Road from Monterey Avenue to Boca Chica Trail, Boca Chica Trail to Cook Street, and from 38th Avenue to Berkey Drive totaling approximately 4.3-miles of roadway in the community of Thousand Palms in the Coachella Valley area of Riverside County.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Mainly, the project will consist of three types of treatment.

Project Number	Project Limits	Treatment Type
D0-0066	Monterey Ave to Boca Chica Trail	Grind existing asphalt and overlay with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA)
D0-0085	Boca Chica Trail to Cook Street	Overlay existing asphalt with HMA
D0-0086	38 th Avenue to 1,300 feet west of Badger St	Grind existing asphalt and overlay with Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA)
	1,300 feet west of Badger St to Berkey Drive	Grind existing asphalt and overlay with HMA

Additional improvements include placement of safety edge and shoulder backing material to protect the outside edge of pavement to prevent edge cracking and pavement edge deterioration, construction of asphalt concrete dike, installation of guardrail, traffic striping, thermoplastic pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, replacement of loop detectors at Varner Road and Monterrey Avenue, Cook Street, and Leopard Street intersections, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to

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improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Varner Road resurfacing project is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1, this needed road repair project would have been shelved until another funding source would be available.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedules of work:

Base Bid 1: Varner Road Resurfacing
Alternative Bid 1: Frontier Communications (Frontier) Facilities Adjustments

The adjustments of a facilities owned by Frontier, are included in the bid package as an alternative bid schedule. If Frontier approves the award of their respective alternative bid schedule, as bid by the apparent low bidder, the cost for the work will be funded by the utility owner through reimbursement letter agreement that will be executed by the Director of Transportation. The Director of Transportation has the authority to execute letter agreements up to \$100,000 per Minute Order dated November 19, 2019 (Agenda Item 3.25).

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid for the sum of all bid schedules.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to resurface approximately 4.3 miles of Varner Road from Monterey Avenue to Cook Street and from 38th Avenue to Berkey Drive. The project in its entirety is consistent with CEQA Section 15301 (c) because the activity does not create additional automobile lanes and involve no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The purpose of this project is to rehabilitate two deteriorated segments of Varner Road, totaling approximately 4.3 miles, to provide the public with a smooth paved roadway that will improve the safety and efficiency of vehicular traffic.

The work is scheduled to begin early 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately two months to complete.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) is proposing to resurface approximately 4.3 miles of Varner Road from Monterey Avenue to Cook Street and from 38th Avenue to Berkey Drive. Varner Road is classified as both a Major and Secondary Highway in the County of Riverside's General Plan. Varner Road is a two to four lane road and currently ranges from 24-100 feet wide with dike and curb/gutter along various segments of the roadway. The project will include the following:

- Cold plane portions of the roadway and place back with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) or Rubberized Mix Asphalt (RHMA) over HMA
- Overlay a portion of the roadway with HMA
- Reconstruction of guardrail including addition of reflective markers
- Reconstruction of concrete cross gutter, spandrel, driveway, and non-compliant ADA ramps
- Reconstruction of asphalt concrete dike
- Replacing existing crash cushion
- Placement of safety edge and shoulder backing
- Signal upgrades to video detection at Monterey Avenue, Cook Street, and Leopard Street
- Minor paved shoulder widening
- Utility adjustments
- Removal of conflicting pavement markers and reflectors
- Striping of roadway, including pavement markers and reflectors
- Salvage/removal and installation of new signs

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project will not acquire right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required for the proposed improvements.

This project is subject to compliance with the Coachella Valley MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7.1 of the Coachella Valley MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance along existing

roadways are considered a covered activity. If tree removal takes place during the migratory bird breeding season from February 15th to August 15th, a pre-construction nesting survey will be conducted pursuant to the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA).

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to resurface approximately 4.3 miles of Varner Road from Monterey Avenue to Cook Street and from 38th Avenue to Berkey Drive. The project in its entirety is consistent with Section 15301(c) because the activity does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

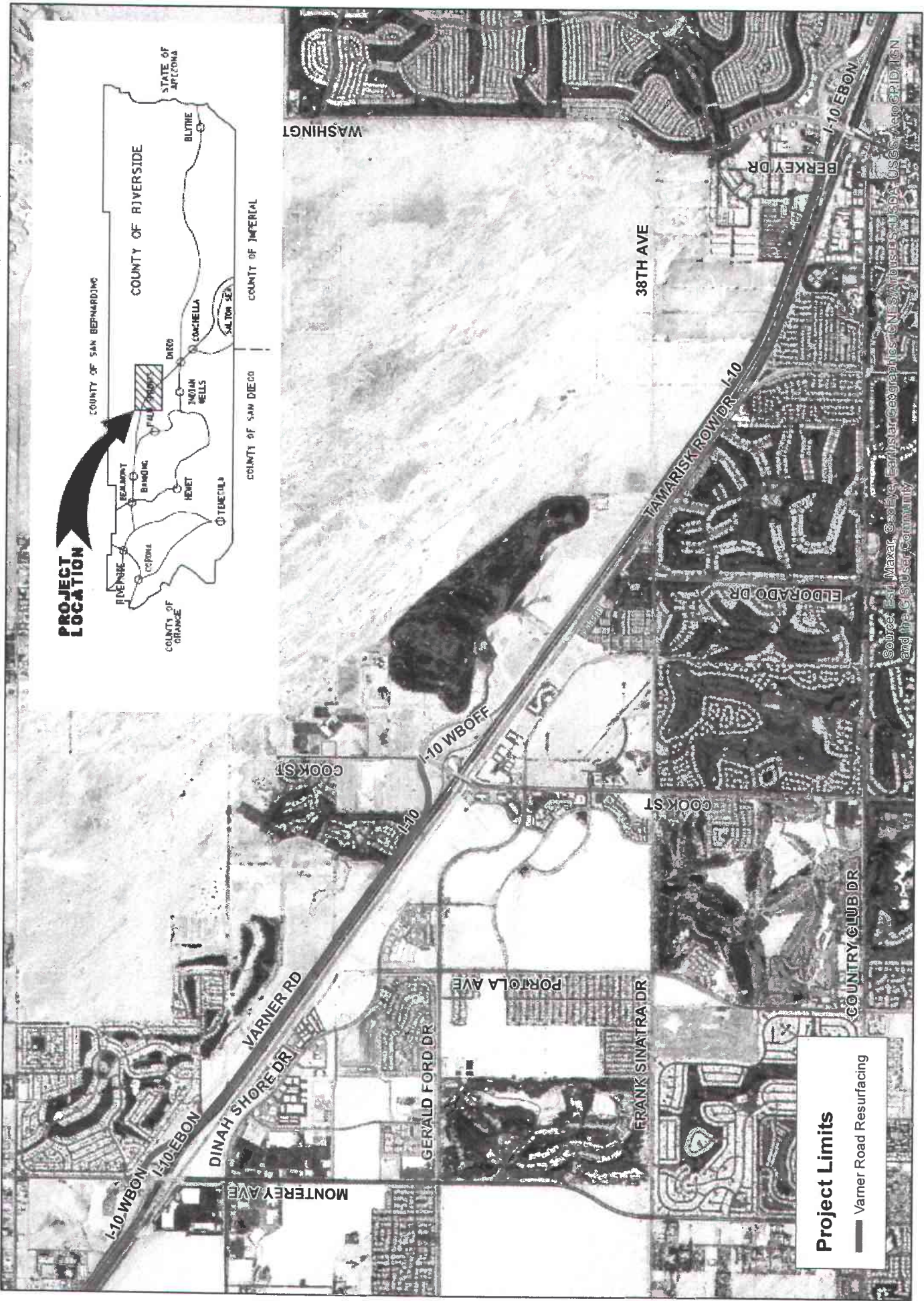

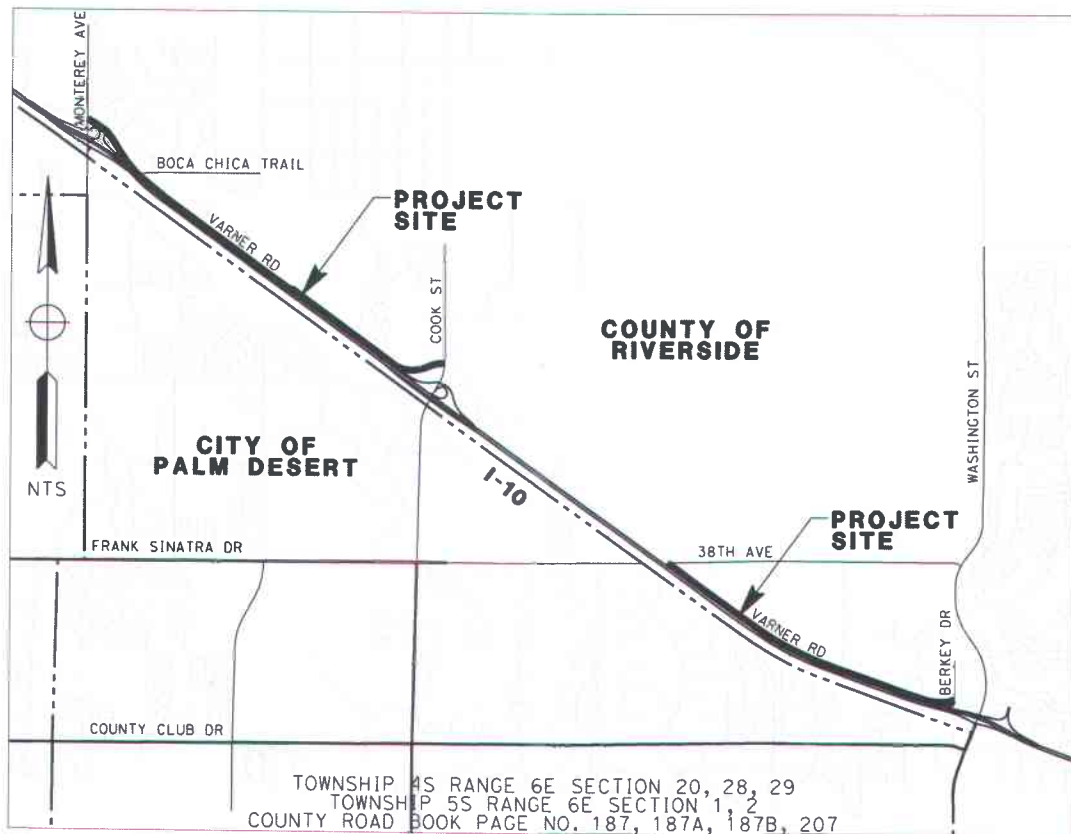
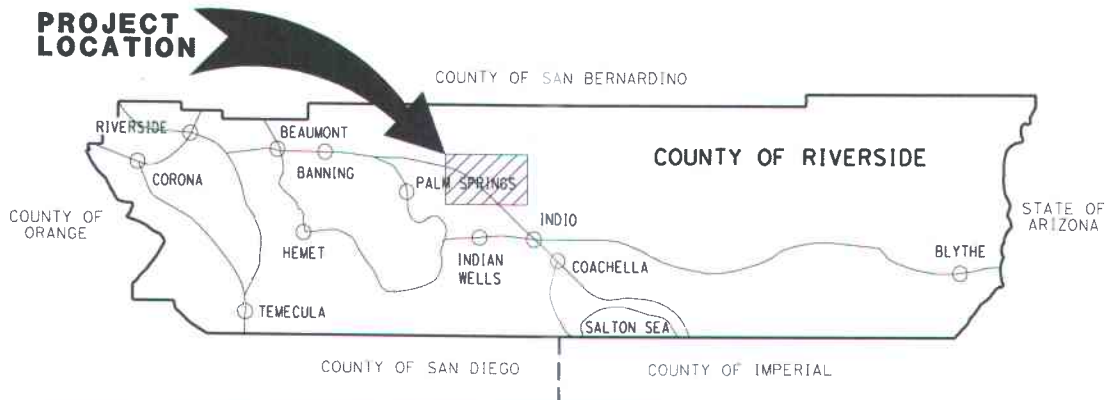
