

SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NO. 348.4931 AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 348 RELATING TO ZONING

This summary is presented pursuant to California Government Code Section 25124(b): a certified copy of the full text of Ordinance No. 348.4931 may be examined at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Riverside, located at 4080 Lemon Street, 1st Floor, Riverside, California.

Ordinance No. 348.4931 is a countywide ordinance adding a new Article XIXm to Riverside County Ordinance No. 348 to establish land use permitting requirements, operating requirements, development standards and approval requirements for industrial hemp cultivation and manufacturing activities within the unincorporated area of Riverside County. Ordinance No. 348.4931 also establishes where industrial hemp activities are prohibited and where they may operate within the County of Riverside. Permitting requirements and development standards include, among others, setbacks, conservation measures and lot size. Ordinance No. 348.4931 also adds definitions related to industrial hemp activities to Ordinance No. 348. Ordinance No. 348.4931 would take effect 30 days after its adoption.
