

**SUBMITTAL TO THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF RIVERSIDE,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

BACKGROUND:

The Advisory Committee for County Service Area 143 Murrieta/Temecula was established on September 9, 1986, by Resolution 86-414, for the purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on policy matters relating to the general development of the facilities, programs and services of County Service Area 143 as authorized under Government Code Section 25212.4.

Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-21 provides that the Board of Supervisors may, in its sole discretion, dissolve an advisory committee if the Board determines that the advisory committee is no longer functioning consistent with Government Code section 25212.4 and Board of Supervisors Policy Nos. A-21 and A-48

Since the CSA 143 Advisory Committee was established in 1986, the County has increased the level of service provided through County Service Area 143. CSA staff also routinely meet with multiple Home-Owners Associations representing the communities within the CSA 143 boundaries. It is now desired by the Third Supervisorial District to dissolve the Advisory Committee for County Service Area 143.

9 WHEREAS, the Advisory Committee for County Service Area No. 143 (hereinafter referred to as
10 “CSA 143 Advisory Committee”) was established on September 9, 1986, by Resolution No. 86-414, for the
11 purpose of advising the Board of Supervisors on policy matters relating to the general development of the
12 facilities, programs and services of County Service Area 143; and

13 WHEREAS, the formation of an advisory committee to give the Board of Supervisors advice
14 regarding a County Service Area’s services and facilities is discretionary under Government Code section
15 25212.4; and

16 WHEREAS, while the County currently has 59 County Service Areas, only 6 have advisory
17 committees; and

18 WHEREAS, Board of Supervisors Policy No. A-21 provides that the Board of Supervisors may, in
19 its sole discretion, dissolve an advisory committee if the Board determines that the advisory committee is no
20 longer functioning consistent with Government Code section 25212.4 and Board of Supervisors Policy Nos.
21 A-21 and A-48; and

22 WHEREAS, since the CSA 143 Advisory Committee was established in 1986, the County has
23 increased the level of service provided through County Service Area 143; and

24 WHEREAS, County Service Area staff meet regularly with multiple Home-Owners Associations
25 representing the communities within County Service Area 143; and

26 WHEREAS, By Resolution 2020-260, superseding Resolution 88-414, it is now desired by the Third
27 Supervisorial District to dissolve the CSA 143 Advisory Committee;
