Section 2. PURPOSE AND AUTHORITY. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the compensation of civil grand juriors pursuant to the authority in Penal Code section 890.
Section 3. COMPENSATION. The fees for civil grand jurors are sixty dollars (\$60) a day for each day's attendance as a grand juror, and the mileage reimbursement applicable to County employees for each mile actually traveled in attending court as a grand juror.
Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.
