BACKGROUND:

Summary

On July 1, 2016, Governor Brown signed landmark legislation enacting the No Place Like Home (NPLH) program to dedicate up to \$2 billion in bond proceeds to invest in the development of permanent supportive housing for persons who are in need of mental health services and are experiencing homelessness, chronic homelessness, or who are at risk of chronic homelessness. Counties are responsible to provide on-site supportive services to tenants for a minimum of 20 years. These services are consistent with services already provided by RUHS-BH.

On August 15, 2018, the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) released a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for Noncompetitive Allocation Funds for NPLH, totaling \$190 million to acquire, design, construct, rehabilitate, or preserve permanent supportive housing. NPLH program provides deferred payment loans to counties applying independently and to counties applying with a Development Sponsor.

On January 29, 2019 (3.17) the Board of Supervisors authorized RUHS-BH to participate in NPLH and accept the Noncompetitive Allocation Funds; conditionally, the County would be required to submit one or more project applications, to utilize the allocation, by February 15, 2021. The County of Riverside was subsequently awarded \$3,340,454 in funding.

On October 23, 2020, HCD amended the NOFA for the Noncompetitive Allocation. To comply with amended NOFA, RUHS-BH, on behalf of Riverside County, is requesting the Board of Supervisors adopt the new resolution authorizing the Director of Behavioral Health to participate in the NPLH funding allocation and execute all related documents in the Noncompetitive Allocation for NPLH.

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

These services are a component of the Department's system of care aimed at improving the health and safety of consumers and the community.

AUTHORIZATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE NO PLACE LIKE HOME PROGRAM NONCOMPETITIVE ALLOCATION

WHEREAS, the State of California, Department of Housing and Community Development ("Department") issued a Notice of Funding Availability, Dated August 15, 2018 as amended on October 30, 2018 and in October 23, 2020, and as may be further amended from time to time, (collectively, the "NOFA") under the No Place Like Home Program ("NPLH" or "Program") authorized by Government Code section 15463, Part 3.9 of Division 5 (commencing with Section 5849.1) of the Welfare and Institutions Code, and Welfare and Institutions Code section 5890;

WHEREAS, the NOFA relates to the availability of approximately \$190 million in Noncompetitive Allocation funds under the NPLH Program; and

WHEREAS, the County of Riverside is a County and an Applicant, within the meaning of section 101(c) of the current NPLH Program Guidelines, dated October 23, 2020 ("Guidelines").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County of Riverside Board of Supervisors for County does hereby determine and declare as follows:

- SECTION 1. That County is hereby authorized and directed to apply for and if awarded, accept the NPLH Program funds, as detailed in the NOFA, up to the amount authorized by section 102 of the Guidelines and applicable state law.
- SECTION 2. That the Director of Behavioral Health, or his or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of County in connection with an award of NPLH Program funds, and to enter into, execute, and deliver any and all documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to evidence the loan of NPLH Program funds, the County's obligations related thereto, and the Department's security therefore. These documents may include, but are not limited to, a State of California Standard Agreement ("Standard Agreement"), a regulatory agreement, a promissory note, a deed of trust and security agreement, and any and all other documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate by the Department as security for,
