2. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Cajalco Road Guardrail Reconstruction Project, in the Communities of El Cerrito and Lake Mathews;
3. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to advertise for bids to be received by the office of the Director of Transportation and Land Management at the Transportation Annex located at 3525 14th Street, Riverside, California 92501. All bids must be received up to the hour of 2:00 p.m., Wednesday, February 3, 2021 at which time bids will be opened; and
4. Direct the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to file the Notice of Exemption with the County Clerk for posting within five (5) working days.

BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) provides for the construction of the Cajalco Road Guardrail Reconstruction Project, between 3,500 feet easterly of Temescal Canyon Road and La Sierra Avenue, in the Communities of El Cerrito and Lake Mathews.

The proposed improvements include removing existing segments of guardrail and replacing them with new guardrail at various locations. Additional work includes placement of guard rail reflective delineators, reconstruction of existing asphalt concrete dike, and other associated work. Approximately 4,000 feet of existing metal beam guardrail will be replaced along Cajalco Road between Temescal Canyon Road and La Sierra Avenue.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

The bid documents include the following bid schedule of work:

Base Bid Schedule: Guardrail Reconstruction

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid.

Environmental Findings

The project proposes to replace existing guardrail and associated safety improvements. These safety improvements to the existing roadway are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the activity does not create additional automobile lanes and involves no expansion of use of the existing roadway and associated facilities.

Caltrans, as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) lead due to federal funding for the project, has determined that this project has no significant impacts on the environment and is categorically excluded from the NEPA requirements under 23 CFR 771.117(c): activity (c)(4).

Impact on Citizens and Businesses

The proposed guardrail improvements will enhance roadway safety within the project limits by providing a safety barrier intended to shield motorists who leave the roadway.

The work is anticipated to begin in the Spring of 2021. The work will be phased to keep the road open during construction as much as possible and will take approximately one month to complete.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$652,885 and will be funded with Highway Safety Improvement Program funds for which the Department successfully competed.

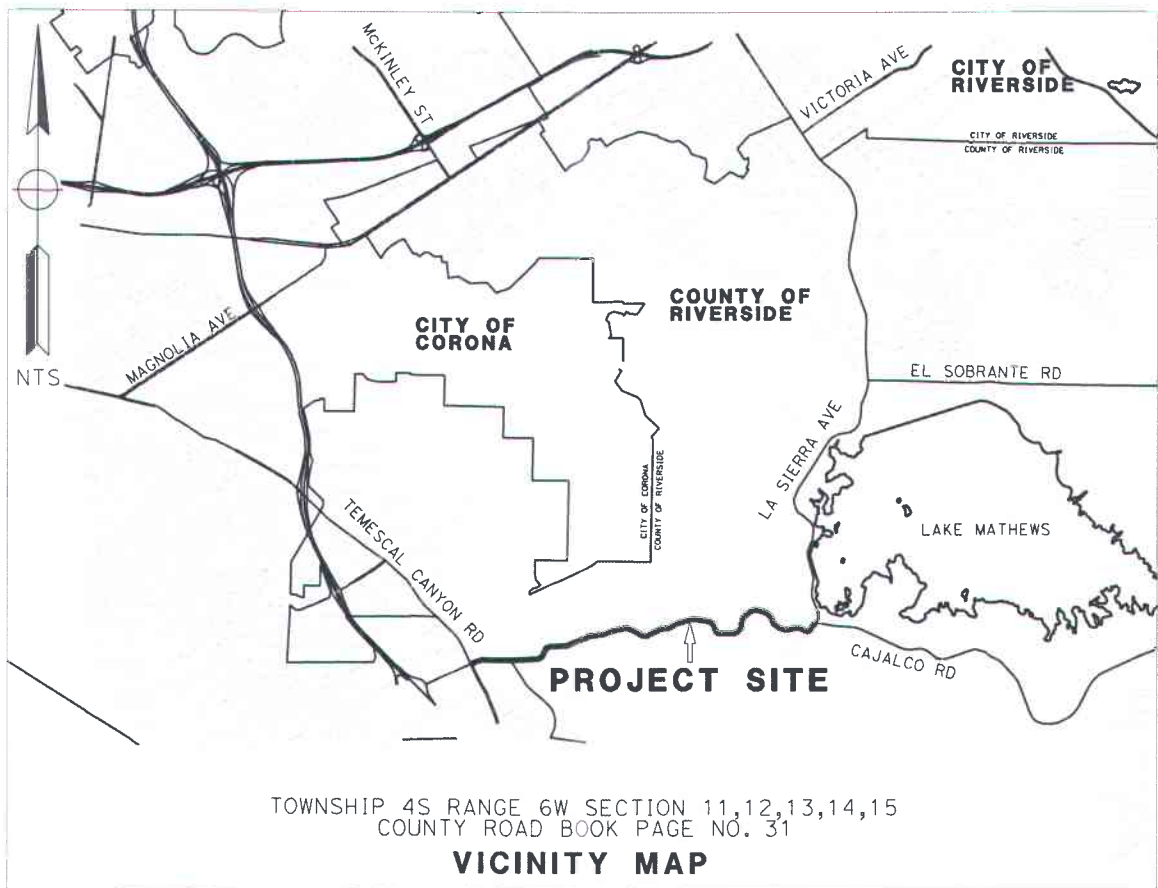
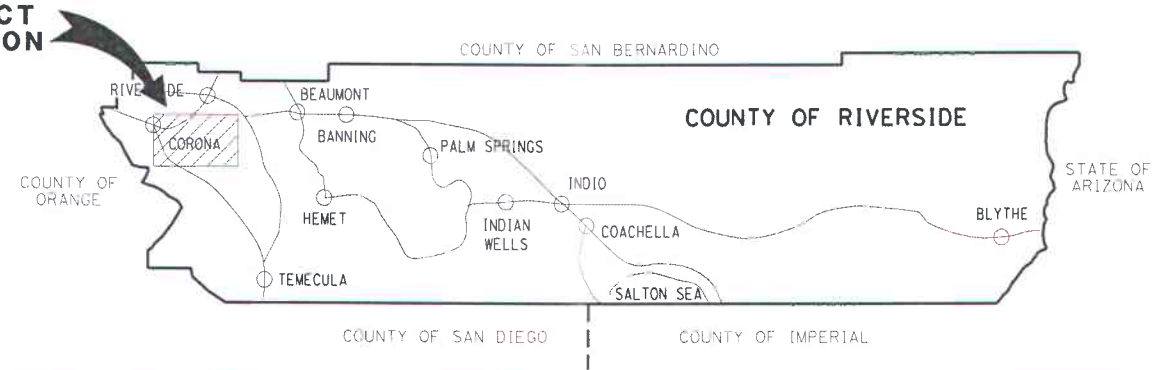

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Riverside County Transportation Department (RCTD) proposes to replace approximately 15,000 linear feet of guardrail along Cajalco Road from Temescal Canyon Road to La Sierra Avenue. Cajalco Road is classified as an Expressway in the County of Riverside General Plan and currently consists of one travel lane in each direction with a total width of 28 to 60 feet. The proposed work will include:

- Replacing the existing guardrail system with the Midwest Guardrail System to meet Caltrans standards
- Replacing the existing ends of the guardrails to meet Caltrans standard
- Installing reflective markers

ENVIRONMENTAL ANALYSIS:

The proposed project does not require additional right-of-way. Temporary construction easements may be required.

This project is subject to compliance with the Western Riverside MSHCP. In accordance with Section 7 of the Western Riverside MSHCP, necessary operation and maintenance activities along existing roadways are considered a covered activity within cell criteria areas. This project is considered to be an operation and maintenance activity and therefore is covered under the Western Riverside MSHCP. The project will comply with construction guidelines provided in Section 7.5.3, as well as Best Management Practices (BMPs) outlined in Appendix C.

The Riverside County Transportation Department has found that the above-described project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), based on the following:

Section 15301 (c) – Existing Facilities – The project proposes to replace existing guardrail with Midwest Guardrail to meet Caltrans standards. Additionally, the project will install reflective markers and extend guardrail segments. These safety improvements to the existing roadway are exempt from CEQA under Section 15301 (c) because the
