


BACKGROUND:

Summary

The Lincoln Street Pavement Restoration and Sidewalk Project (Project) consists of the reconstruction of pavement along Lincoln Street from 5th Street to 62nd Avenue and the addition of sidewalk along the east side of Lincoln Street from 5th Street to 7th Street. The proposed sidewalk will increase the network of sidewalks that residents use to access services in downtown Mecca in District 4.

Roadway resurfacing is needed due to the deteriorated pavement conditions. Where there is no curb and gutter, the proposed reconstruction of Lincoln Street consists of pulverizing the existing pavement and compacting it in place, followed by a base pavement course of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and an overlay of Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA). Where curb and gutter are existing or proposed, the proposed reconstruction of Lincoln Street consists of complete removal of existing pavement, the placement of aggregate base material, followed by a base pavement course of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) and an overlay of Rubberized Hot Mix Asphalt (RHMA).

Additional improvements on the east side of Lincoln Street between 5th Street and 7th Street, include the construction of concrete sidewalk, curb and gutter, curb ramps, driveways, the relocation or replacement of fences and gates, and other associated work.

On April 28, 2017, Senate Bill 1 (SB1) was passed to improve the state's aging transportation infrastructure, particularly roads and bridges. Because of this, the County is now able to improve the condition of roads in need of resurfacing or reconstruction and has included them in the County Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Lincoln Street is one of Riverside County's priority projects approved for use of the new Gas Tax/SB1 funds. Without SB1 this needed road repair project would have been shelved until funding became available.

The Transportation Department will select the contractor based upon the lowest responsive and responsible bid of the sum of all bid schedules.

The submitted plans and specifications have been approved as to form by County Counsel.

Environmental Findings

By minute order dated March 12, 2019 (Item 3.30), the Board of Supervisors found the Project exempt under Section 15301(c) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines because the Project consists of operation, maintenance and repair of an existing public facility, and there is no expansion of existing roadway to provide additional travel lanes.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The pavement improvements will benefit residents and businesses by improving the road driving surface, reducing wear and tear on vehicles, and improving vehicular safety. The sidewalk improvements will improve the network of walkway connectivity throughout downtown Mecca, a community that is highly walking-oriented.

Additional Fiscal Information

The construction contract is estimated to cost approximately \$2,787,275 and construction is anticipated to be completed in summer of 2021. The pavement restoration and sidewalk work will be funded with Gas Tax/SB1.

There are no General Funds used in this project.

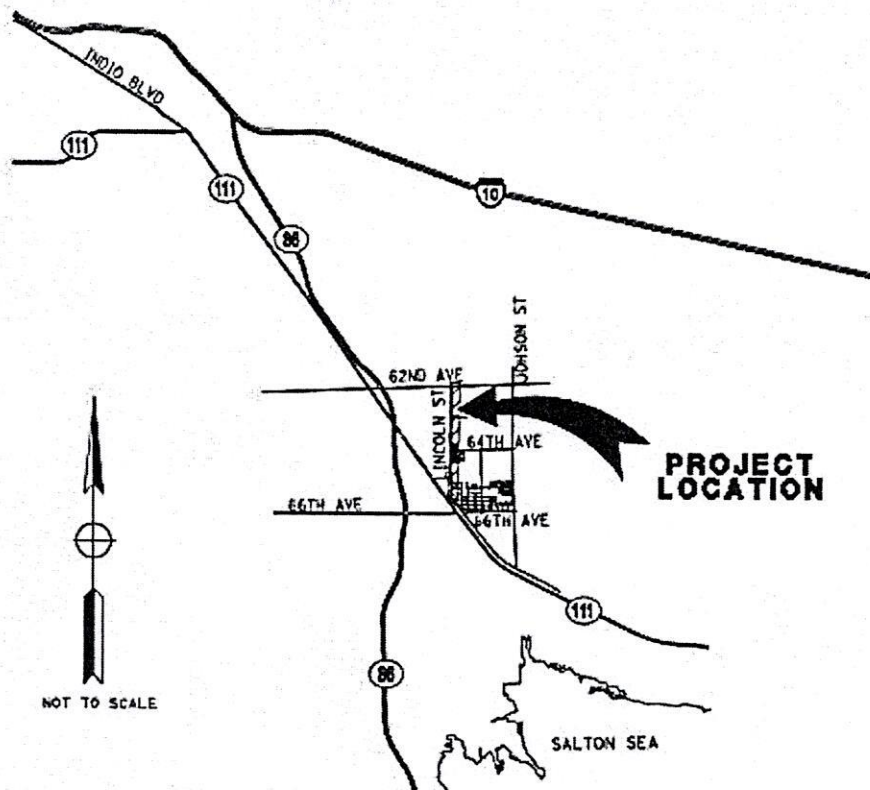
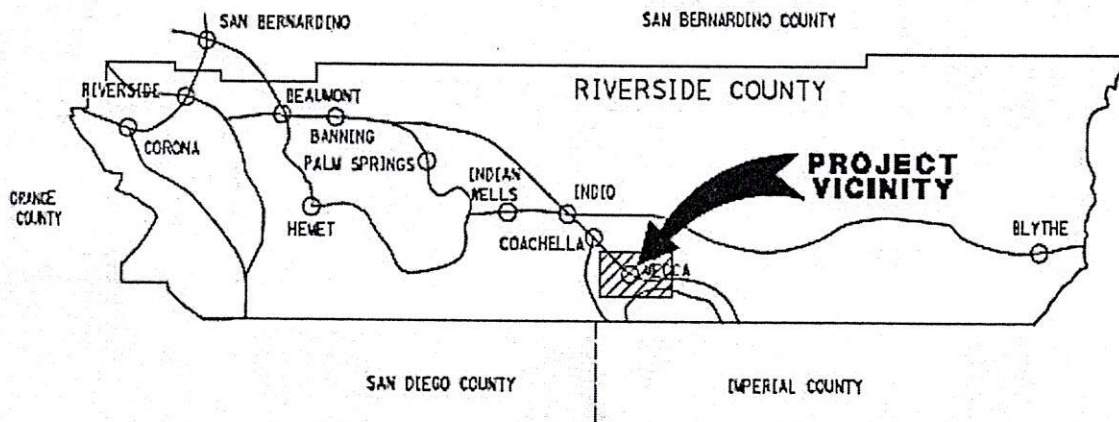

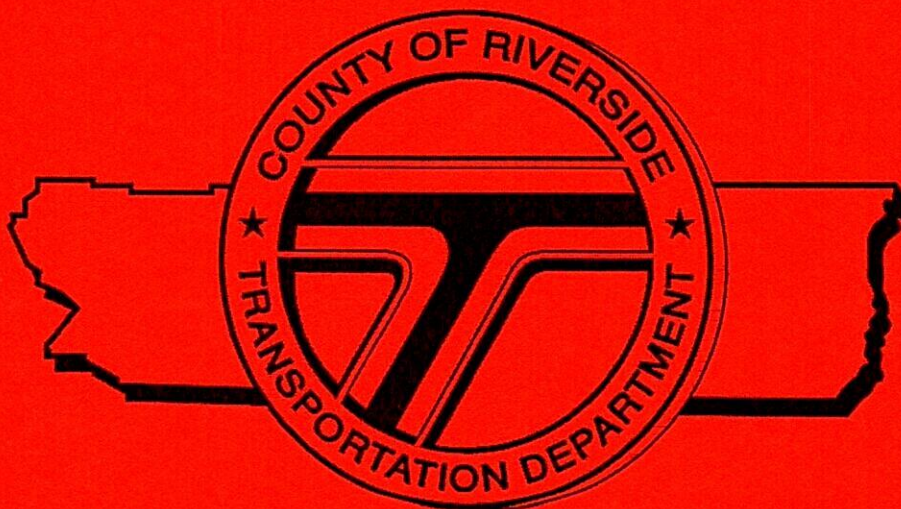
