# **BACKGROUND:**

# Summary

On December 15, 2020, the San Jacinto Mayor signed the First Amendment to the Agreement for Law Enforcement Services between the City of San Jacinto and the County of Riverside. This First Amendment modifies the level of law enforcement service provided by the Sheriff's Department with the addition of two (2) Deputy Sheriff positions assigned to Problem Oriented Policing (POP) and reduction of one (1) Deputy Sheriff position assigned to the Post-Release Accountability and Compliance Team (PACT). The department is requesting the addition of two (2) Deputy Sheriff PCNs for this amendment as the PACT position is still filled and reimbursed through the Probation Department. County Counsel has approved the Amendment as to form.

Sheriff's staff anticipates this change will result in an estimated increase of \$256,900 in Contract Law Enforcement Revenue for FY2020-21. The department is recommending these budget adjustments now as it could not anticipate them to include in its FY20/21 budget request.

# Impact on Residents and Businesses

This is an agreement with the Sheriff's Department for law enforcement services, which the City of San Jacinto approved and executed on behalf of its citizens. All costs for this service will be fully recovered through Board-approved rates.
